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## ORDINANCE 2022-326-E

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE TO JOIN WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA AND OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL UNITS AS A PARTICIPANT IN THE STATE'S SETTLEMENTS WITH CVS HEALTH CORPORATION; CVS PHARMACY, INC.; TEVA PHARMACEUTICALS INDUSTRIES, LLC; AND ALLERGAN FINANCE, LLC; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has suffered harm from the opioid epidemic and further recognizes that the entire State of Florida has suffered harm from the opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has filed an action pending in Pasco County, Florida, and a number of Florida Cities and Counties have also filed an action <u>In re: National Opiate Litigation</u>, MDL No. 2804 (N.D. Ohio) (the "Opioid Litigation") and the City of Jacksonville is a litigating participant in that action; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has entered into settlement agreements with Defendants, CVS Health Corporation, CVS Pharmacy, Inc., Teva Pharmaceuticals Industries, Ltd., and Allergan Finance, LLC (collectively "CVS/Teva/Allergan Settlement"); and

whereas, the City of Jacksonville is a participant in the State of Florida's unified plan, known as the "Florida Plan," for the allocation and use of prospective settlement dollars from opioid related litigation, inclusive of the allocation and use of prospective settlement dollars from the Endo Settlement; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the City of Jacksonville's participation in the CVS/Teva/Allergan Settlement as memorialized in the executed Settlement Agreements and Releases as placed On File with the Legislative Services Division.

Section 2. Authorization to Execute and Implement. The Council hereby approves, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, the Subdivision Settlement Participation Forms in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and to take, or cause to be taken, for and on behalf of the City, such further action as is necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance.

Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the State of Florida has requested the immediate execution and return of the Subdivision Settlement Participation Forms.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
