5 **ORDINANCE 2022-121**

6 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2022 EDITION OF THE
7 JACKSONVILLE ORDINANCE CODE; ADOPTING BY
8 REFERENCE THE 46TH-56TH SUPPLEMENTS TO THE 1990
9 EDITION OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF
10 JACKSONVILLE AND THE CITY CHARTER, INCLUDING ALL
11 STATE LAWS, VOTED LAWS AND ORDINANCES OF GENERAL
12 AND PERMANENT NATURE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL
13 THROUGH MARCH 22, 2022; RATIFYING GENERAL AND
14 PERMANENT ORDINANCES SO ADOPTED AND CONSIDERED
15 BY COUNCIL THROUGH MARCH 22, 2022; DIRECTIVE TO
16 CIVICPLUS CODIFIERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
17 DATE.

19 **WHEREAS**, the legislative act of statutory adoption, or
20 codification, is a mechanism for establishing a single, unified
21 Ordinance Code, which summarizes and codifies all separate Ordinances
22 which have independently amended various portions of the Ordinance
23 code; and

24 **WHEREAS**, codification adopts the Ordinance Code of the City of
25 Jacksonville as the official statutory law of the Consolidated City;
26 and

27 **WHEREAS**, each such adoption includes within it the previously
28 adopted and codified Ordinances as well as all the City's Ordinances
29 amending the Ordinance Code adopted by the City Council in the
30 previous sessions from the previous year or years; and

31 **WHEREAS**, this codification provides to the people of

1 Jacksonville a definitive version of the Ordinance Code; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the Florida courts have regularly and consistently
3 approved this procedure, *see, e.g., State ex rel. Badgett v. Lee*, 22
4 So.2d 804 (Fla 1945); *Thompson v. Intercounty Tel. & Tel. Co.*, 62
5 So.2d 16 (Fla. 1952); *Rodriguez v. Jones*, 64 So.2d 27 (Fla 1953),
6 *Spangler v. Florida State Tpk. Auth.*, 106 So. 2d 421, 423 (Fla. 1958);
7 and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1990 the City last adopted a complete revision of
9 the City's Official Ordinance Code; and

10 **WHEREAS**, for approximately ten years subsequent to the adoption
11 of that 1990 Ordinance Code, the City Council adopted, by Ordinance,
12 supplements to that 1990 Ordinance Code; and

13 **WHEREAS**, around the year 1999 or 2000 the City's Ordinance Code
14 has been published electronically; and

15 **WHEREAS**, due to the convenience of electronic publication, the
16 City Council has not adopted these supplements by Ordinance; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the City Council seeks to return to its process of
18 codification on a regular basis; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in 2017 the Council began the readoption process in
20 Ordinance 2017-236-E, the Council adopted supplements through March
21 16, 2017; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2017-236-E was the last adoption of the last
23 supplement to the 1990 Ordinance Code, approximately 10 supplements
24 have been published; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the City Council seeks to provide that same clarity to
26 the Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville as the Legislature
27 provides to Florida Statutes through Legislature's codification
28 process; now therefore

29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1.** The Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville,
31 1990 Edition, was adopted by Ordinance 91-305-142 and readopted with

9 incorporated therein by Ordinance 97-204-E, Supplement 12
10 incorporated therein by Ordinance 97-963-E, Supplement 13
11 incorporated therein by Ordinance 98-382-E, Supplement 14
12 incorporated therein by Ordinance 98-626-E, Supplement 15
13 incorporated therein by Ordinance 1999-42-E, and Supplements 16-45
14 incorporated therein by Ordinance 2017-236-E. The City Council hereby
15 amends by the adoption by reference herein the 1990 Edition of the
16 Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville, as modified above and by
17 Supplements 46th-56th hereby referenced herein. Copies of Supplements
18 46-56 are attached hereto as **Revised On File**, having been **Revised On**
19 **File** for at least ten days immediately preceding the passage of this
20 Ordinance and shall remain as a permanent record of the Council. The
21 1990 Edition of the Ordinance Code as amended and modified by
22 Supplements 1-56 is adopted and enacted as the official codification
23 of the general and permanent Ordinances of the City.

24 **Section 2.** All Ordinances and parts thereof of a general
25 and permanent nature incorporated within the supplements hereby
26 adopted, which were enacted by the Council through March 22, 2022,
27 are ratified by incorporation hereby. These Ordinances are listed in
28 **Revised On File** document and made a part hereof.

29 **Section 3. Directive to CivicPlus Codifiers.** The CivicPlus
30 Codifiers are hereby directed to: (i) update the title page of the
31 Jacksonville Ordinance Code to read as the "2022 Edition", and (ii)

1 insert the following language as the updated Preface to the 2022
2 Edition of the Jacksonville Ordinance to read as follows:

3 **PREFACE**

4 This Code constitutes a recodification of the general and
5 permanent Ordinances of the City of Jacksonville, Florida.

6 Source materials used in the preparation of the Code were the
7 1990 Code, as supplemented through Supplement 56, and Ordinances
8 subsequently adopted by the Jacksonville City Council. The source of
9 each section is included in the history note appearing in parentheses
10 at the end thereof. The absence of such a note indicates that the
11 section is new and was adopted for the first time with the adoption
12 of the Code. By use of the comparative tables appearing in the back
13 of this Code, the reader can locate any section of the 1990 Code, as
14 supplemented, and any subsequent Ordinance included herein.
