Department of Economic Opportunity, through the Florida Housing Finance Corporation, and \$1,315,494.20 in program income. These funds will be used to support the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) program. The SHIP program grant and income funds must be committed to eligible projects no later than June 30, 2023 and must be fully expended for completed projects no later than June 30, 2024.

Section 2. Purpose. The Florida Housing Finance Corporation provides funding to local governments as an incentive to partnerships that produce and preserve affordable homeownership and multifamily housing. The SHIP program was designed to serve very low, low, and moderate-income families. SHIP funds may be used for emergency repairs, new construction, rehabilitation, down payment and closing costs assistance, acquisition of property for affordable housing, matching dollars for federal housing grants and programs, homeownership counseling and the Foreclosure Intervention Program. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed uses of the SHIP funds is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the state of Florida Projected SHIP Estimates for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

Section 3. Approval of Positions. There are hereby approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 22-117, attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this reference. Said positions are fully funded by SHIP grant dollars and will provide services in support of the SHIP program.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
