5 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A CONTINUATION GRANT;
6 APPROPRIATING \$2,981,294.00 IN ANNUAL HOUSING
7 OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS (HOPWA)
8 PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT
9 OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT TO PROVIDE
10 HOUSING ASSISTANCE AND RELATED SUPPORTIVE
11 SERVICES TO ELIGIBLE LOW-INCOME PERSONS LIVING
12 WITH HIV/AIDS AND THEIR FAMILIES WITHIN DUVAL
13 COUNTY, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-002; PURPOSE OF
14 APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION FOR
15 REALLOCATION OF GRANT FUNDS AS MORE PARTICULARLY
16 DESCRIBED HEREIN; APPROVING A PROGRAM MANAGER
17 POSITION, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 23-002; PROVIDING
18 FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
22 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
23 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
24 listed in subsection (b):

31 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

1 The funding above is an appropriation of \$2,981,294.00 in
2 annual grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and
3 Urban Development (HUD) for the Housing Opportunities for
4 Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program. The HOPWA program is
5 administered by the Housing and Community Development
6 Division and was established to provide housing assistance
7 and related supportive services to eligible low-income
8 persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families.

9 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
10 Section 1 is to provide funding for housing assistance and related
11 supportive services to eligible low-income persons living with
12 HIV/AIDS and their families. The HOPWA program provides funding that
13 can be used for a wide range of housing, social services, program
14 planning, and development cost expenditures for eligible persons and
15 their families. Housing assistance may include the acquisition,
16 rehabilitation or new construction of housing units, costs for
17 facility operations, rental assistance, and short-term payments to
18 prevent homelessness. In addition, an essential component to
19 providing housing assistance for this targeted, special needs
20 population is the coordination and delivery of supportive services.
21 Consequently, HOPWA funds may also be used for services that include,
22 but are not limited to, assessment and case management, substance
23 abuse treatment, mental health treatment, nutritional services, job
24 training and placement assistance, and assistance with daily living
25 activities. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed
26 uses of HOPWA funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
27 herein by this reference.

28 **Section 3. Authorization for Reallocation of Grant Funds.**
29 In the event a sub-recipient is unable or unwilling to accept an
30 award of HOPWA funds, the funds may be reallocated to the next
31 eligible awardee using the same method and criteria normally applied

1 by the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission for
2 award of HOPWA funds.

3 **Section 4. Approval of Position.** There is hereby
4 approved the Program Manager position more fully described in R.C.
5 23-002, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this
6 reference. Said position is fully funded by HOPWA grant dollars and
7 will provide services in support of the HOPWA program.

8 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
10 without the Mayor's signature.
