AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2022 EDITION OF THE JACKSONVILLE ORDINANCE CODE; ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 46TH-56TH SUPPLEMENTS TO THE 1990 EDITION OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE CITY CHARTER, INCLUDING ALL STATE LAWS, VOTED LAWS AND ORDINANCES OF GENERAL AND PERMANENT NATURE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL THROUGH MARCH 22, 2022; RATIFYING GENERAL AND PERMANENT ORDINANCES SO ADOPTED AND CONSIDERED BY COUNCIL THROUGH MARCH 22, 2022; DIRECTIVE TO CIVICPLUS CODIFIERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the legislative act of statutory adoption, or codification, is a mechanism for establishing a single, unified Ordinance Code, which summarizes and codifies all separate Ordinances which have independently amended various portions of the Ordinance code; and

WHEREAS, codification adopts the Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville as the official statutory law of the Consolidated City; and

WHEREAS, each such adoption includes within it the previously adopted and codified Ordinances as well as all the City's Ordinances amending the Ordinance Code adopted by the City Council in the

this codification provides to

previous sessions from the previous year or years; and

people of Jacksonville a definitive version of the Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, the Florida courts have regularly and consistently approved this procedure, see, e.g., State ex rel. Badgett v. Lee, 22 So.2d 804 (Fla 1945); Thompson v. Intercounty Tel. & Tel. Co., 62 So.2d 16 (Fla. 1952); Rodriguez v. Jones, 64 So.2d 27 (Fla 1953), Spangler v. Florida State Tpk. Auth., 106 So. 2d 421, 423 (Fla. 1958); and

WHEREAS, in 1990 the City last adopted a complete revision of the City's Official Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, for approximately ten years subsequent to the adoption of that 1990 Ordinance Code, the City Council adopted, by Ordinance, supplements to that 1990 Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, around the year 1999 or 2000 the City's Ordinance Code has been published electronically; and

WHEREAS, due to the convenience of electronic publication, the City Council has not adopted these supplements by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council seeks to return to its process of codification on a regular basis; and

WHEREAS, in 2017 the Council began the readoption process in Ordinance 2017-236-E, the Council adopted supplements through March 16, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2017-236-E was the last adoption of the last supplement to the 1990 Ordinance Code, approximately 10 supplements have been published; and

WHEREAS, the City Council seeks to provide that same clarity to the Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville as the Legislature provides to Florida Statutes through Legislature's codification process; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

The Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville, Section 1. 1990 Edition, was adopted by Ordinance 91-305-142 and readopted with Supplements 1, 2 and 3 incorporated therein by Ordinance 93-171-86, Supplement 4 incorporated therein by Ordinance 93-548-327, Supplement incorporated therein by Ordinance 93-929-396, Supplement incorporated therein by Ordinance 94-1064-587, Supplement 7 incorporated therein by Ordinance 95-340-244, Supplement 8 incorporated therein bу Ordinance 95-912-501, Supplement 9 incorporated therein by Ordinance 96-112-67, Supplement 10 incorporated Ordinance Supplement 11 therein by 96-694-389, incorporated therein by Ordinance 97-204-E, Supplement 12 incorporated Ordinance Supplement 13 therein by 97-963-E, incorporated therein by Ordinance 98-382-E, Supplement 14 incorporated therein by Ordinance 98-626-E, Supplement 15 incorporated therein by Ordinance 1999-42-E, and Supplements 16-45 incorporated therein by Ordinance 2017-236-E. The City Council hereby amends by the adoption by reference herein the 1990 Edition of the Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville, as modified above and by Supplements 46th-56th hereby referenced herein. Copies of Supplements 46-56 are attached hereto as **Second Revised On File**, having been Second Revised On File for at least ten days immediately preceding the passage of this Ordinance and shall remain as a permanent record of the Council. The 1990 Edition of the Ordinance Code as amended and modified by Supplements 1-56 is adopted and enacted as the official codification of the general and permanent Ordinances of the City.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts thereof of a general and permanent nature incorporated within the supplements hereby adopted, which were enacted by the Council through March 22, 2022, are ratified by incorporation hereby. These Ordinances are listed in Second Revised On File document and made a part hereof.

PREFACE

This Code constitutes a recodification of the general and permanent Ordinances of the City of Jacksonville, Florida.

Source materials used in the preparation of the Code were the 1990 Code, as supplemented through Supplement 56, and Ordinances subsequently adopted by the Jacksonville City Council. The source of each section is included in the history note appearing in parentheses at the end thereof. The absence of such a note indicates that the section is new and was adopted for the first time with the adoption of the Code. By use of the comparative tables appearing in the back of this Code, the reader can locate any section of the 1990 Code, as supplemented, and any subsequent Ordinance included herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
