This allocation supports programs and services 2 aimed at drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime 3 prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officer 4 5 programs for the citizens of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida. A Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that 6 7 this appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund complies with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, is attached 8 9 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

10 In addition to the above, this appropriation includes a transfer of \$12,500 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund for 11 12 the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section 111.365, Ordinance Code, a transfer of \$7,500 from the Fund to the Police 13 Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police 14 Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340, Ordinance Code, 15 and \$66,160 from the Fund to reimburse the General Fund for 16 17 forfeiture-related expenditures in accordance with Section 932.7055(4)(c), Florida Statutes. 18

Approval and Authorization. 19 Section 3. There is hereby 20 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 21 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 22 the City, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City 23 of Jacksonville and I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. 24 (the "Agreement") in substantially the same form as has been placed 25 On File with the Office of Legislative Services.
