6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$336,000 (\$186,000
7 FROM CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT
8 AND \$150,000 FROM THE COUNCIL MEMBER -
9 LEGISLATIVE CONTINGENCY - CD 7 ACCOUNT) TO THE
10 SAFETY AND CRIME REDUCTION CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT
11 TO FUND CRIME REDUCTION COUNTY WIDE; PROVIDING
12 FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023;
13 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
17 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
18 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
19 listed in subsection (b):

27 The funding is an appropriation of \$336,000 (\$186,000 from
28 the City Council President Contingency account and \$150,000
29 from the Council Member - Legislative Contingency - CD 7
30 account) to a contingency account to be utilized by the
31 Safety and Crime Reduction Commission to make

1 recommendations to the City Council to reduce crime
2 countywide.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
4 Section 1 is to provide funding to reduce crime county wide. The
5 Safety and Crime Reduction Commission will make recommendations of
6 programs to Council and the Council will address the recommendations
7 through separate legislation.

8 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this
9 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2022-
10 2023.

11 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
13 without the Mayor's signature.
