Due to the impacts resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, including limitations with regard to workforce density and implementation of other protective measures, the City Council approved Global Amendment One to Economic Development Agreements via Ordinance 2021-449-E, which authorized certain employees working remotely to count with respect to New Jobs for calendar years 2020 and 2021, provided certain conditions were met. Global Amendment Two would continue to allow remote workers to count towards the New Job requirements after 2021 and through the end of the applicable agreement term, provided that the employees reside within the Jacksonville MSA and the New Job was based, but not necessarily located, at the Project Parcel. The Amendment would pertain to each of the EDAs detailed on Exhibit A.
