ORDINANCE 2022-411

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR DISCLAIMING AN OPENED AND IMPROVED ALLEY IN BLOCK 67, ESTABLISHED IN THE RE-PLAT OF PART OF LAKE SIDE PARK, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 6, PAGE 44 OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 14, AT THE REQUEST OF 1931 BLANDING LLC, SUBJECT TO RESERVATION OF A TEN-FOOT UTILITY EASEMENT IN FAVOR OF TECO PEOPLES GAS THAT SPANS FIVE FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF AN EXISTING GAS PIPE IN THE CLOSURE AREA; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An opened and improved alley in Block 67, established in the Re-Plat of Part of Lake Side Park, as recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 44 of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 14, a description and depiction of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as an alley at the request of 1931 Blanding LLC (the "Applicant"); provided however, there is reserved unto TECO Peoples Gas a ten-foot utility easement that spans five feet on either side of an existing gas pipe located in the closure area.

The Applicant paid the right-of-way closure application fee of \$2,091.00 and the closure and abandonment with encroachment fee of

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\$516.00, both of which have been deposited into the General Fund. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant owns property adjacent to the closure area at 1931 Blanding Boulevard (R.E. No. 093675-0000) and is requesting the closure in order to construct a self-storage facility, subject to the conditions set forth herein.

Section 3. Hold Harmless Covenant. The closure and abandonment by the City of its interests in the alley is subject to Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the alley shall not be recorded in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
