WHEREAS, the District Council Member for District 7 has 19 20 submitted a letter of resignation pursuant to section 99.012(3)(d), 21 Florida Statutes, to run for an elected position in the Florida 22 Legislature; and

23 WHEREAS, the effective date of the resignation was designated as being the earlier of either the date he would take office in the 24 25 Florida Legislature, if elected, or the date his District 7 successor 26 would take office; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 99.012(3)(d), Florida Statutes, the 27 resignation is irrevocable, creating a vacancy in the District 7 28 29 Council seat as of the resignation effective date; and

30 WHEREAS, Section 5.06 of the Charter of the City of Jacksonville provides that upon a vacancy occurring under these circumstances, a 31

special election may be called by resolution of the Council; and

2 WHEREAS, because of such vacancy and the benefits attributed to the constituents and citizens of District 7 by having a district 3 Council Member represent their interests, economy of resources can 4 5 best be achieved if the Council makes simultaneous provisions for the special election of the District 7 seat in conjunction with the State-6 7 wide, multi-county, County and District offices primary election set for Tuesday, August 23, 2022 and general election on Tuesday, November 8 9 8, 2022; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Special Elections Called - District 7 Council 11 Section 1. Seat; Qualifying Period, First Election and General Election Provided 12 The Council hereby declares the vacancy in the District 7 seat 13 for. of the City Council as the result of the resignation of Council Member 14 15 Gaffney effective the earlier of either the date he would take office in the Florida Legislature, if elected, or the date his District 7 16 17 successor would take office; that a Special First Consolidated Government Election in accordance with the provisions of Section 18 19 5.06, Charter of the City of Jacksonville, will be held on Tuesday, 20 August 23, 2022, for the purpose of electing the District 7 Council 21 Member for such vacated Office, to serve the unexpired term of the previous District 7 Council Member. If no candidate receives a 22 23 majority of the votes of the Special First Election, then, in that 24 event, the two candidates with the highest vote totals in the Special 25 First Election shall participate in a Special General Election to be 26 held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. In the event more than one 27 candidate receives the second highest vote total, then each such 28 candidates' name, as well as the name of the candidate with the 29 highest vote total, shall be on the ballot for the Special General Election. The qualifying period for candidates to be voted upon in 30 31 the Special First Election hereby called shall begin at 12:00 p.m.

3 Candidate Section 2. Establishing the Qualifying by 4 Petition Deadline. For those candidates seeking to qualify for this special election for the District 7 City Council seat via the voter 5 petition process, the Council hereby establishes the candidate 6 7 qualifying by petition deadline to be 12:00 p.m. on Friday, June 3, 2022. 8

9 Section 3. Requesting Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council 10 Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage of this legislation upon introduction is requested. The nature of the emergency is that a 11 vacancy has been created in the Office of the District 7 City Council 12 seat and time is needed for a qualifying period and to establish the 13 candidates to be included on the printed August ballot, as well as 14 sufficient time to afford the Duval County Supervisor of Elections 15 the opportunity to properly assess petitions and meet the ballot 16 17 printing deadlines.

18 Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become 19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 20 without the Mayor's signature.
