Funding of the forgivable loans and deferred principal loan will require future appropriation by the Jacksonville City Council and will be sought after construction commences and the time frame for actual completion can be determined. Construction is currently projected to commence in 2022.

The grants (forgivable loans) and deferred principal loan will be funded from the General Fund (00111) pursuant to the Downtown Preservation and Revitalization Program and through the Downtown Economic Development Fund (00116) in an amount up to \$1,536,350 for redevelopment of the 323 E. Bay Street property.

This project would not be feasible without support from the City through the DPRP, or alternative capital subsidy. The building requires significant rehabilitation to ensure ADA compliance and environmental abatement of hazardous materials to make it ready to be used once again and contribute to the City's tax base in its highest and best use.
