AN ORDINANCE NAMING A NEW COMMUNITY CENTER IN MAYPORT LOCATED AT DAVID WAYNE PACK PARK, 4875 OCEAN STREET, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32233 PURSUANT TO SECTION 122.105 (PUBLIC BUILDINGS, PUBLIC FACILITIES AND PUBLIC PARKS NAMING AND RENAMING PROCEDURES), ORDINANCE CODE, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 13, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "WILLIAM 'BILL' GULLIFORD, JR. COMMUNITY CENTER"; WAIVING SECTION 122.102 (NAMING OF AND SIGNAGE ON PUBLIC FACILITIES REGULATED), ORDINANCE CODE, TO NAME THE COMMUNITY CENTER AFTER A LIVING PERSON; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 WHEREAS, the City is constructing a new community center, 19 approximately 5,900 square feet, at the David Wayne Pack Park in the 20 Mayport community located at 4875 Ocean Street, Jacksonville, Florida 21 32233, which is expected to open to the public in summer 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has not yet finalized the name
for the community center at David Wayne Pack Park; and

24 WHEREAS, the Jacksonville City Council desires to name the new 25 community center at David Wayne Pack Park in honor of the service and 26 contributions of William "Bill" Gulliford, Jr. to the Beaches 27 communities and to the City of Jacksonville pursuant to Section 28 122.105, Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, in 1988 Mr. Gulliford was elected mayor of Atlantic Beach and served until 1993. Prior to that, he served on the Atlantic Beach City Commission; and WHEREAS, Mr. Gulliford was elected to the Jacksonville City
 Council in 2011 to represent District 13; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, Mr. Gulliford was awarded the Charles D. Webb Award, for extraordinary commitment to public service, by out-going Council President, Stephen Joost, and he also received the Mary L. Singleton Award for his service on the Jacksonville City Council during the 2014-2015 Council year; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Gulliford was unanimously elected by the 9 Jacksonville City Council to serve as President for the 2013-2014 10 Council Year; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gulliford continues his service to the community by advocating for the Beaches and the Mayport community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gulliford and his wife, Harriet, have raised four children in Atlantic Beach, where they have resided since 1972, and share nine grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 122.105, Ordinance Code, for naming of the community center to be established at the David Wayne Pack Park have been met, the public hearings have been held, and the Planning and Development Department has submitted its report to the Council; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
