**Bill Summary:** This bill appoints of Mia Jones as a member of the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Board of Trustees, replacing Richard Patsy, for a partial term to expire on June 30th, 2024.

**Background Information:** The Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Board of Trustees is established pursuant to Article 22, Jacksonville Charter, as the sole entity responsible for administering the Pension Fund. Sections 175.061 and 185.05, Florida Statutes, provide that two of the members of the board must be appointed by the legislative body of the municipality. Section 22.02(a), Jacksonville Charter, provides that the trustees appointed by the City Council shall have at least 10 years of professional financial experience.

Ms. Jones is the Chief Executive Officer of AGAPE Community Health Center, Inc., the Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) in Duval County. Ms. Jones previously served on the Jacksonville City Council from 2003 to 2008 after serving as the Director of Minority Business Affairs for the Duval County Public Schools. Ms. Jones resides in Council District 8.
