Bill Summary: This bill amends Sections 117.101, 117.102, 117.105, and 117.108, and creates new Sections 117.111 and 117.112, *Ordinance Code* regarding grant processes and reporting.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to clarify that state, federal and or other public or private grant awards must comply with State and Federal requirements for funding received through federal or state grants, and Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, where applicable. Grant applications to state and federal agencies submitted on behalf of the City will include vendors who have been reviewed by the Office

of Grants and Compliance and when feasible utilize a competitive procurement process pursuant to Chapter 126 (Procurement Code). Quarterly, beginning on October 1, 2022, the Office of Grants and Compliance will submit a report to council that includes grant awards from the preceding quarter and list the vendor, award amount,

awarding agency, description of use, description of procurement method and emergency status.
