Bill Summary: This legislation is a Second amendment to the Service Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and We Care Jacksonville, Inc., to retroactively extend the contract to September 30, 2022.

Background Information: Through Ordinance 2021-22-E, the City of Jacksonville entered into a Services Contract with We Care Jacksonville, Inc. for a collaborative system of health care for uninsured residents of Jacksonville through April 8, 2022 as part of the JaxCareConnect Program, with \$80,000 appropriated for funding in Fiscal Year 2021.

In August 2021, We Care Jacksonville, Inc. received additional funding of \$51,000 for its JaxCareConnect Program through Ordinance 2021-379-E. The First Amendment to the Services Contract was approved by Ordinance 2021-379-E to include the additional funding but did not extend the contract expiration date of April 8, 2022.

There is \$42,000 remaining on the Services Contract that We Care Jacksonville, Inc. would like to utilize.

Policy Impact Area: Contract extension

Fiscal Impact: The contract extension will allow for expenditure of the remaining \$42,000.
