**Bill Summary:** The bill appropriates \$1,127,609.25 from the Fire Station #64 land acquisition account to the Fire Station #64 construction costs account to provide funding necessary to complete construction of the station. The bill amends the 2021-2025 Capital Improvement Program to reflect the revised cost figures for the two accounts. Emergency passage on one cycle is requested in order to expedite the transfer of the funds and complete the construction of the station in a timely manner.

**Background Information:** New Fire Station #64 is located at Dunn Avenue and Harts Road on the Northside. The property acquisition for the project has long since been completed and the residual funds in the acquisition account are needed to cover cost increases that have been experienced in the construction phase. The station is in an area identified by JFRD and by the Tri Data consultant report as one where response times need to be reduced so, swift completion of construction and occupancy of the station is needed to help ensure public safety in the area.

Policy Impact Area: Fire station construction

**Fiscal Impact:** The bill appropriates \$1,127,609.25 from the Fire Station #64 land acquisition account to the construction costs account to complete the project.
