AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 0.09± ACRES 6 LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 AT 3701 BUCKMAN STREET, BETWEEN 27TH STREET EAST AND 28TH STREET EAST (R.E. NO. 131742-0000), OWNED BY CHANELL L. DAVIS, AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, FROM COMMERCIAL 10 NEIGHBORHOOD (CN) DISTRICT TO RESIDENTIAL LOW DENSITY-40 (RLD-40) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND 11 12 CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, PURSUANT TO 13 FUTURE LAND USE MAP SERIES (FLUMS) SMALL-SCALE 14 AMENDMENT APPLICATION NUMBER L-5719-22C; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED 15 HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION 16 17 FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN 18 EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville adopted a Small-Scale 21 Amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan for the purpose of revising 22 portions of the Future Land Use Map series (FLUMs) in order to ensure 23 the accuracy and internal consistency of the plan, pursuant to 24 companion application L-5719-22C; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure consistency of zoning district with 25 26 the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and the adopted companion Small-Scale 27 Amendment L-5719-22C, an application to rezone and reclassify from 28 Commercial Neighborhood (CN) District to Residential Low Density-40 29 (RLD-40) District was filed by Zach Miller, Esq., on behalf of the 30 owner of approximately 0.09± acres of certain real property in Council 31 District 7, as more particularly described in Section 1; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department, in order to ensure consistency of this zoning district with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, has considered the rezoning and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

5 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the application 6 and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

7 WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee, after due 8 notice, held a public hearing and made its recommendation to the 9 Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after due notice, held a public hearing, and taking into consideration the above recommendations as well as all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, the Council finds that such rezoning is consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan adopted under the comprehensive planning ordinance for future development of the City of Jacksonville; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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18 Subject Property Location and Description. Section 1. The 19 approximately 0.09± acres are located in Council District 7 at 3701 20 Buckman Street, between 27th Street East and 28th Street East (R.E. 21 No. 131742-0000), as more particularly described in Exhibit 1, dated 22 May 3, 2022, and graphically depicted in Exhibit 2, both of which are 23 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (the 24 "Subject Property").

Section 2. Owner and Applicant Description. The Subject
Property is owned by Chanell L. Davis. The applicant is Zach Miller,
Esq., 3203 Old Barn Court, Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida 32082; (904)
651-8958.

29 Section 3. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property, 30 pursuant to adopted companion Small-Scale Amendment Application L-31 5719-22C, is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Commercial

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Neighborhood (CN) District to Residential Low Density-40 (RLD-40)
 District.

3 Section 4. Contingency. This rezoning shall not become 4 effective until thirty-one (31) days after adoption of the companion 5 Small-Scale Amendment; and further provided that if the companion 6 Small-Scale Amendment is challenged by the state land planning agency, 7 this rezoning shall not become effective until the state land planning 8 agency or the Administration Commission issues a final order determining the companion Small-Scale Amendment is in compliance with 9 10 Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.

11 Section 5. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein 12 shall **not** be construed as an exemption from any other applicable 13 local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or 14 approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or 15 approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development 16 or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, 17 representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), 18 developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the 19 subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Issuance of this rezoning does not approve, 20 21 promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or 22 restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

Section 6. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and the Council Secretary.
