A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE WORK OF KEVIN T. GAY AS THE CEO AND FOUNDER OF OPERATION NEW HOPE ON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Kevin T. Gay is a native of Jacksonville and a graduate of the University of Florida. He is the CEO and Founder of Operation New Hope; he has many years of entrepreneurial experience and a deep commitment to revitalizing urban neighborhoods. He combines this with his strong faith and a special interest in helping the underserved in communities who seek a way out of the cycle of addiction, poverty, and incarceration; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Gay left corporate America in 1999 and founded 20 Operation New Hope to create a new model for community development. 21 In June of 2002, Mr. Gay was invited to meet with President George 22 W. Bush and Secretary of Labor Elaine Chao and this meeting led to 23 Operation New Hope being selected by the White House to develop the 24 first national model for Prisoner Re-entry called Ready4Work. This 25 employment-based re-entry model was then introduced in 16 other cities 26 around the country. Ready4Work Jacksonville has gained national 27 attention because of its impact in reducing recidivism; and

28 WHEREAS, Mr. Gay is a founding member of Reconcile Jacksonville, 29 which has been responsible for partnering with over 40 black and 30 white churches since 1992. In 2003, the City of Jacksonville nominated 31 Mr. Gay for a national award through Neighborhoods USA and on May 22, 1 2003 he and nine others from around the country received the 2 prestigious Neighborhoods USA Notables Award. Mr. Gay served on 3 President-Elect Barack Obama's Advisory Council for the White House 4 Office of Faith Based and Neighborhood Partnerships during the 5 transition in 2009 and 2010. He also served on the transition teams 6 for Jacksonville Mayor's Alvin Brown in 2011 and on Mayor Lenny 7 Curry's in 2015; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, Mr. Gay was the only CEO from a non-profit 8 9 organization to be honored by the Jacksonville Business Journal with 10 the Ultimate CEO Award. Mr. Gay is a graduate of the Leadership Jacksonville Class of 2015 and co-hosted Operation Reform in 11 Jacksonville in November 2015. Operation Reform was a national 12 bipartisan summit on criminal justice reform and reentry solutions. 13 14 the largest gathering of thought-leaders, It was government officials, re-entry providers, and media; now therefore 15
