Type of Action: Agreement authorization

Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the Traffic Control Agreement with Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association, and authorizes Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to enforce Pablo Creek Reserve Neighborhood Speed Limit of 20 MPH. The Pablo Creek Reserve Board unanimously approved the agreement at the May 4, 2022, meeting.

Background Information: The internal roads of the Pablo Creek Reserve community, located near Hodges Boulevard, are private and the speed limit has been posted at a maximum of 20 miles per hour. Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association has requested that JSO perform traffic monitoring on the private roads within the community.

Policy Impact Area: Pablo Creek Reserve Neighborhood-traffic control

Fiscal Impact: Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association will pay the City the actual amount of any costs incurred for services requested and subsequently provided by the City which exceed the ordinary level of traffic control service.
