Bill Summary: This bill renews the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Aetna Recycling, Inc. Clean Debris & Yard Trash Recycling Facility located at 8050 Old Kings Road, Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida 32219 with a modification to allow for the addition of clean debris. The initial CON authorizing operation of a yard trash recycling facility was granted by Ordinance 2013-458-E. The renewal of the certificate is made after application, notice, and hearing.

Background Information: Based upon recommendations of the Director of the Planning and Development Department, the Chief of the Solid Waste Division, the Chief of the Environmental Quality Division, and the Florida Department of Health in Duval County, it is deemed that the Facility would serve the public convenience and provide a needed service to the citizens of Duval County. The Aetna Recycling may accept up to 1,000 tons of clean debris and 275 tons of yard trash & clean wood per operating day based on six days a week and up to 311 working days per year. Yard trash and clean debris recycling are beneficial to the city recycling goals.
