ORDINANCE 2022-408-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$857,148.41 FROM THE MCCOYS CREEK SMITH STREET BRIDGE REMOVAL PROJECT TO THE MCCOYS CREEK RESTORATION PROJECT FOR COMPLETION OF THE MCCOYS CREEK BOULEVARD CLOSURE AND CHANNEL IMPROVEMENTS/RESTORATION PROJECTS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 22-077; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2022-2026 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2021-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE MCCOYS CREEK BOULEVARD CLOSURE AND IMPROVEMENTS/RESTORATION PROJECTS; CHANNEL PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(Revised B.T. 22-077, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev B.T. 22-077, June 21, 2022 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference)

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$857,148.41 from the completed McCoys Creek Smith Street Bridge Removal project to the McCoys Creek Restoration project to provide additional funding in the amount of \$350,000.00 for the McCoys Creek Boulevard Closure project and additional funding in the amount of \$507,148.41 for the McCoys Creek Channel Improvements/Restoration project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to appropriate funds to the McCoys Creek Restoration project to offset additional costs for the McCoys Creek Boulevard Closure and Channel Improvements/Restoration projects. This additional funding is needed to cover the costs for additional grading and various challenges that arise when constructing large-scale capital projects. These additional funds will also help to offset the increased costs that have occurred due to market volatility.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the McCoys Creek Boulevard Closure and Channel Improvements/Restoration projects as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of these projects.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute

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an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
