4 **ORDINANCE 2022-461-E**

5 AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT  
6 OF JAMES CARROLL AS CHIEF OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY  
7 AND STORMWATER MAINTENANCE DIVISION OF THE  
8 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF  
9 JACKSONVILLE PURSUANT TO SECTION 32.302,  
10 *ORDINANCE CODE*; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF  
11 SECTION 32.302, *ORDINANCE CODE*, THAT THE  
12 DIVISION CHIEF HAVE A FOUR-YEAR DEGREE FROM AN  
13 ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IN ENGINEERING,  
14 CONSTRUCTION, OR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND BE  
15 REGISTERED BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA AS A  
16 PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE  
17 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment.** The Council  
21 hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of James Carroll as Chief of  
22 the Right-of-Way and Stormwater Maintenance Division of the  
23 Department of Public Works of the City of Jacksonville pursuant to  
24 Section 32.302, *Ordinance Code*. Attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** is the  
25 *curriculum vitae* of James Carroll.

26 **Section 2. Waiver of Certain Requirements in Section**  
27 **32.302, *Ordinance Code*.** The requirements outlined in Section  
28 32.302, *Ordinance Code*, that the Division Chief have a four-year  
29 degree from an accredited college or university in engineering,  
30 construction, or construction management and be registered by the  
31 State of Florida as a Professional Engineer are hereby waived

1 recognizing Mr. Carroll has extensive, relevant professional  
2 experience and qualifications to fill this position.

3       **Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**  
4 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this  
5 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the  
6 Public Works Department would like to fill the position of Chief of  
7 the Right-of-Way and Stormwater Maintenance Division as soon as  
8 possible to ensure the continued efficient and uninterrupted  
9 operation of that Division.

10       **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
12 without the Mayor's signature.
