## ORDINANCE 2022-530

Legal Description

A parcel of land, being a portion of Francis Richard Grant, Section 56, and a portion of the Joseph Summeral Grant, Section 57, all being in Township 3 South, Range 27 East Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

For point of reference, commence at a point which is the intersection of the. southwesterly prolongation of the Southerly right-of-way line of Baymeadows Road (a 100 foot wide-right-of-way, as now established), and run North $89^{\circ} 44^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East, along said Southwesterly prolongation of said southerly right-of-way line, a distance of 35.00 feet to a point in said Southerly right-of-way tine of Baymeadows Road; thence continue North $89^{\circ} 44^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East, along last said right-of-way line, a distance of $3,247.24$ feet to a point, said point being the most Northwesterly corner of a tract of land as described In Official Records Volume 4275, Page 756, Public Records of said County; run thence along the Westerly boundary of said tract, South $00^{\circ} 15^{\prime} 59^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 290.00 feet to a Point, thence North $89^{\circ} 44^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East, along the Southerly boundary of said tract, a distance of 113.71 ; run thence South $01^{\circ} 56^{\prime} 50$ " East, departing from last said Southerly line, a distance of 701.45 feet to a point in the Southerly line of aforementioned Section 56, said line being the dividing line between said Section 56 and 57, Joseph Summeral Grant; run thence North $68^{\circ} 53^{\prime} 28^{\prime \prime}$ East along said dividing line a distance of 464.68 feet to the Point of Beginning for this description:

From the Point of Beginning thus described run thence North $34^{\circ} 30^{\prime} 23^{\prime \prime}$ West departing from said dividing line, a distance of 400.00 feet; run thence North $07^{\circ} 29^{\prime} 43^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 107.16 feet; run thence North $44^{\circ} 44^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 100.00 feet; run thence North $00^{\circ} 15^{\prime} 59 "$ West., a distance of 50.00 feet to a point in the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Dix Ellis Trail, as now established; run thence North $89^{\circ} 44^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime}$ East along said Southwesterly right-of-way line, a distance of 32.98 feet to a point of curvature therein; run thence 394.86 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 270.00 feet, and a central angle of $83^{\circ} 47^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$, said arc being subtended by a chord which bears South $48^{\circ} 22^{\prime} 15^{\prime \prime}$ East, 360.60 feet to a point, thence continue along said Southwesterly right-of-way line 145.29 feet along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 270,00 feet, and a central angle of $30^{\circ}$ $49^{\prime} 51^{\prime \prime}$ said arc being subtended by a chord which bears South $08^{\circ} 56^{\prime} 26^{\prime \prime}$ West, 143.54 feet to a point; thence continue along said Southwesterly right-of-way line of said Dix Ellls Trail, South $34^{\circ} 30^{\prime} 23^{\prime \prime}$ East, a distance of 212.38 feet; thence South $55^{\circ} 29^{\prime} 37^{\prime \prime}$ West, 190.00 feet; thence North $34^{\circ} 30^{\prime} 23^{\prime \prime}$ West, 129.76 feet to the Point of Beginning.
