For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, 16 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated 17 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 18 19 listed in subsection (b): 20 (B.T. 22-088, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 21 by this reference) 22 (a) Appropriated from: See B.T. 22-088 \$100,000.00 23 24 (b) Appropriated to: See B.T. 22-088 \$100,000.00 25 Explanation of Appropriation: 26 (C) 27 The funding above is an appropriation of funds originally appropriated by Ordinance 2021-149-E to the Florida 28 29 Department of Health in Duval County for payment of 30 expenses incurred due to ongoing COVID-19 response efforts.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 1 Section 2. 2 Section 1 is to provide funding for COVID-19 response efforts administered by the Florida Department of Health in Duval County 3 ("DOH"). These funds were originally appropriated by Ordinance 2021-4 149-E but were recaptured to the general fund at the beginning of 5 fiscal year 2021-2022 due to a lack of carryover language in the 6 7 initial appropriation. This appropriation is necessary to pay the DOH for COVID-19 related expenses and ongoing services rendered since 8 9 enactment of the original appropriation. As stated in 2021-149-E, 10 response efforts for which these funds may be expended include, but are not limited to, interviewing, evaluating and monitoring clients 11 on matters related to COVID-19, providing education and guidance on 12 COVID-19 related issues, and counseling on isolation/quarantine 13 parameters. These funds may also be used to support ongoing COVID-14 19 vaccination planning and distribution efforts and other health-15 16 related needs. The DOH is required to submit a detailed summary of 17 expenditure of the funds appropriated hereby, to include invoices, to the Director of the Finance and Administration Department on a 18 19 quarterly basis. A final detailed report shall also be due after all 20 funds have been expended.

21 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this 22 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2022-23 2023.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
