5 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS;
6 APPROPRIATING \$6,000,000 FROM A DESIGNATED
7 SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FOR PUBLIC
8 SERVICE GRANTS; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY
9 THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE OF
10 THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION;
11 WAIVING THE CONFLICTING PROVISION OF SECTION
12 118.802 (ANNUAL LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION FOR PUBLIC
13 SERVICE GRANTS), PART 8 (PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS),
14 CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, DUE
15 TO THE NEED FOR SEPARATE LEGISLATION FROM THE
16 ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE LUMP SUM
17 APPROPRIATION FOR PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS;
18 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
22 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
23 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
24 listed in subsection (b):

31 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is being

1 appropriated from the designated Council Contingency account for
2 Public Service Grants.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The Public Service Grant
4 appropriation shall be allocated to the Acute, Prevention, and Self-
5 Sufficiency categories of Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs as
6 outlined in **Exhibit 2** and shall be used only for the purpose of the
7 listed Public Service Grant Appropriations and may not be transferred
8 or reallocated for any other utilization within the respective
9 department. Public Service Grants are subject to the provisions of
10 Chapter 118, *Ordinance Code*. The appropriations made herein shall be
11 awarded as grants-in-aid to the miscellaneous agencies and shall not
12 require additional legislation for distribution of funds. Pursuant
13 to Section 118.808, *Ordinance Code*, the Public Service Grant Council
14 shall forward a complete list of the Public Service Grants recipients
15 and funding allocation to the Council Auditor's office, the Office
16 of the Mayor, the City Council and the Director of the Finance and
17 Administration Department.

18 **Section 3. Oversight Department.** The Office of Grants and
19 Contract Compliance of the Finance and Administration Department
20 shall oversee the project described herein.

21 **Section 4. Waiving conflicting provision of Section 118.802**
22 **(Annual Lump Sum Appropriation for Public Service Grants), Part 8**
23 **(Public Service Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code.**
24 The conflicting provision of Section 118.802 (Annual Lump Sum
25 Appropriation for Public Service Grants), *Ordinance Code*, referring
26 to "the annual budget ordinance" is hereby waived. Waiver of Section
27 118.802, *Ordinance Code*, is necessary because the Public Service
28 Grant lump sum appropriation for the 2022-2023 annual budget will be
29 considered by Council by this Ordinance 2022-509 and not in the annual
30 budget ordinance 2022-504.

31 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
