4 **ORDINANCE 2022-267-W**

5 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS PERSONAL
6 PROPERTY OF THE CITY; DECLARING THAT CERTAIN
7 1979 CHEVROLET MALIBU (VIN 1T19L9D483566,
8 VEHICLE NUMBER 0046-10) VALUED AT \$15,000 TO BE
9 SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING
10 THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE CITY TO
11 TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO THE MOG
12 COLLECTION, LLC., D/B/A BRUMOS COLLECTION AT NO
13 COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 122.812(C),
14 *ORDINANCE CODE*; WAIVING SECTION 122.305
15 (UNLAWFUL USE OF CITY MARKINGS AND TAGS), PART
16 3 (MUNICIPAL VEHICLES), CHAPTER 122 (PUBLIC
17 PROPERTY), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ALLOW FOR CERTAIN
18 1979 CHEVROLET MALIBU (VIN 1T19L9D483566,
19 VEHICLE NUMBER 0046-10) TO RETAIN ITS
20 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE INSIGNIA;
21 DESIGNATING THE FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE
22 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT TO MONITOR
23 ACTUAL USE OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR A
24 REVERTER; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE
25 AND THE CORPORATE SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AN
26 AGREEMENT FOR SURPLUSSING OF CITY PERSONAL
27 PROPERTY BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND
28 THE MOG COLLECTION, LLC., D/B/A BRUMOS
29 COLLECTION; REPEALING SECTION 111.396 (MOTOR
30 VEHICLE SAFETY PROGRAM FUND), PART 3 (PUBLIC
31 SAFETY AND COURTS), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE

1 AND TRUST ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING
2 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

3
4 **WHEREAS**, the original "Beat the Heat" Safety and Education
5 program was started by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office in 1984; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the program was designed to educate young people of the
7 communities about the problems of illegal drug and alcohol use,
8 educate about the problems of alcohol or drug impaired driving, to
9 promote a better understanding between the police and the communities
10 they serve, and to encourage everyone not to drag race in the street;
11 and

12 **WHEREAS**, the "Beat the Heat" car was 1979 Chevrolet Malibu police
13 vehicle retrofitted into a racetrack certified drag car, and a picture
14 of the car and information on the program more specifically described
15 in **Exhibit 1**, attached hereto; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the program is no longer in existence, and the
17 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office has submitted the vehicle for surplus;
18 and

19 **WHEREAS**, the MOG Collection, LLC., d/b/a Brumos Collection would
20 like to maintain the educational value of the vehicle by having it
21 as part of a museum; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the MOG Collection, LLC., d/b/a Brumos Collection has
23 a showcase museum where the vehicle could be on display for that
24 stated public purpose; now therefore

25 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

26 **Section 1. Declaration of Surplus.** The City hereby
27 declares that certain 1979 Chevrolet Malibu (VIN 1T19L9D483566,
28 Vehicle Number 0046-10) valued at \$15,000as more particularly
29 described in the property transfer form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**
30 and incorporated herein by this reference ("Subject Property"), to
31 be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes

1 the appropriate City officials to transfer title of the Subject
2 Property to the Mog Collection, LLC., d/b/a Brumos Collection, Inc.
3 at no cost, pursuant to Section 122.812(c), *Ordinance Code*. A copy
4 of the certificate from the Director of Procurement certifying
5 compliance with provisions of Chapter 122, *Ordinance Code*, is attached
6 hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and incorporated herein by this reference.

7 **Section 2. Public Purpose.** The surplus vehicle was used as
8 an educational tool by the Jacksonville Sherriff's Office to educate
9 Jacksonville youth about the dangers of street drag racing. In 1984,
10 a race car engine was installed to assist in the JSO educational
11 tool. Brumos Racing was one of the sponsors of the car and provided
12 funding for its operation. By the City donating the car to be housed
13 at the Brumos Museum and to be displayed in other locations, the
14 education and safety awareness can continue. The City of Jacksonville
15 finds that providing the surplussed vehicle to the MOG Collection,
16 LLC., d/b/a Brumos Collection for a continued education about the
17 dangers of street drag racing, is a valid public purpose. For these
18 foregoing reasons and pursuant to Section 122.812(a), *Ordinance Code*,
19 the public interests support the disposal of the property at no cost
20 to the MOG Collection, LLC., d/b/a Brumos Collection.

21 **Section 3. Waiver of Section 122.305 (Unlawful use of City**
22 **markings and tags), Part 3 (Municipal Vehicles), Chapter 122 (Public**
23 **Property), *Ordinance Code*.** The provisions of Section 122.305
24 (Unlawful use of City markings and tags), Part 3 (Municipal Vehicles),
25 Chapter 122 (Public Property), *Ordinance Code*, are hereby waived to
26 allow for certain 1979 Chevrolet Malibu (VIN 1T19L9D483566, vehicle
27 number 0046-10) to retain its Jacksonville Sheriff's Office insignia
28 for the purpose of the MOG Collection to use for display to promote
29 the original "Beat the Heat" Safety and Education program.

30 **Section 4. Fleet Management Division to Monitor Actual Use**
31 **of Subject Property.** The Fleet Management Division of the Finance and

1 Administration Department will be the designated agency to monitor
2 the museum educational use of the Subject Property in accordance with
3 the purposes set forth herein.

4 **Section 5. Reverter.** The disposition authorized herein is
5 conditioned upon using the said vehicle for the purposes set forth
6 herein and is conditioned upon agreeing to convey the vehicle back
7 to the City of Jacksonville in the event that the vehicle is not used
8 for those purposes.

9 **Section 6. Approval and Authorization.** The Mayor, his
10 designee and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute
11 an Agreement for the surplussing of City personal property between
12 the City of Jacksonville and the MOG Collection, LLC., d/b/a Brumos
13 Collection, attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**, and incorporated herein by
14 this reference.

15 **Section 7. Repealing Section 111.396 (Motor Vehicle Safety**
16 **Program Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts), Chapter 111 (Special**
17 **Revenue and Trust Accounts), Ordinance Code.** Section 111.396 (Motor
18 Vehicle Safety Program Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts),
19 Chapter 111 (Special Revenue And Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*, is
20 hereby repealed in its entirety. A copy of the repealed Section
21 111.396 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 5**.

22 **Section 8. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
24 without the Mayor's signature.
