7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$800,000.00 FROM THE
8 DISABLED PARKING FINES SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO
9 PAY FOR ACCESSIBILITY AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY
10 IMPROVEMENTS FOR QUALIFIED PHYSICALLY DISABLED
11 PERSONS IN DUVAL COUNTY AND TO FUND PUBLIC
12 AWARENESS PROGRAMS IN DUVAL COUNTY CONCERNING
13 PHYSICALLY DISABLED PERSONS, AS INITIATED BY
14 B.T. 22-086; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
20 listed in subsection (b):

27 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

28 The funding above is an appropriation from the Disabled
29 Parking Fines Special Revenue Fund to pay for accessibility
30 and equal opportunity improvements for qualified
31 physically disabled persons in Duval County. In addition,

1 a portion of the funds will be used to pay for public
2 awareness programs in Duval County concerning physically
3 disabled persons.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
5 Section 1 is to provide funds for adaptive recreation, student
6 scholarships, summer camp sponsorships, the Mayor's Disability
7 Council initiatives, emergency assistance programs, the wheelchair
8 ramp program, educational symposiums, and to remediate inaccessible
9 electronic files to ensure online accessibility. The Disabled Parking
10 Fines Special Revenue Fund is a permanent fund into which fines
11 received from citations issued to individuals who park illegally in
12 designated accessible parking spaces are deposited to pay the costs
13 of various programs and improvements as authorized by Section
14 316.008(4), Florida Statutes, and as outlined in Section 804.1012,
15 *Ordinance Code.*

16 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
18 without the Mayor's signature.
