Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for adaptive recreation, student scholarships, summer camp sponsorships, the Mayor's Disability Council initiatives, emergency assistance programs, the wheelchair ramp program, educational symposiums, and to remediate inaccessible electronic files to ensure online accessibility. The Disabled Parking Fines Special Revenue Fund is a permanent fund into which fines received from citations issued to individuals who park illegally in designated accessible parking spaces are deposited to pay the costs of various programs and improvements as authorized by Section 316.008(4), Florida Statutes, and as outlined in Section 804.1012, Ordinance Code.
