GENERAL INFORMATION

Application for Rezoning Ordinance 2022-0442 seeks to rezone approximately 2.84± acres of property from Industrial Business Park (IBP) to Industrial Light (IL). The property is located in the Light Industrial (LI) land use category within the Urban Area of the Future Land Use Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan. The request to rezone the property is to allow for industrial light uses similar to those existing in surrounding area.

STANDARDS, CRITERIA AND FINDINGS

Pursuant to Section 656.125 of the Zoning Code, an applicant for a proposed rezoning bears the burden of proving, by substantial competent evidence, that the proposed rezoning is consistent

with the City's comprehensive plan for future development of the subject parcel. In determining whether a proposed rezoning is consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, the Planning and Development Department considers several factors, including (a) whether it is consistent with the functional land use category identified in the Future Land Use Map series of the Future Land Use Element; (b) whether it furthers the goals, objectives and policies of the Comprehensive Plan; and (c) whether it conflicts with any portion of the City's land use regulations. Thus, the fact that a proposed rezoning is permissible within a given land use category does not automatically render it consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, as a determination of consistency entails an examination of several different factors.

1. Is the proposed rezoning consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan?

Yes. The Planning and Development Department finds that the subject property is located in the Light Industrial (LI) functional land use category as defined by the Future Land Use Map series (FLUMs) contained within the Future Land Use Element (FLUE) adopted as part of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan. According to the Category Description of the Future Land Use Element (FLUE), Light Industrial (LI) is a category, which provides for the location of industrial uses, which have fewer objectionable impacts than Heavy Industrial (HI) on residential areas such as noise, odor, toxic chemicals and wastes. Site access to roads classified as collector or higher is preferred. Truck storage is a permitted use within the LI land use category.

Therefore, the proposed rezoning is consistent with the FLUMs adopted as part of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan pursuant to Chapter 650 Comprehensive Planning for Future Development of the Ordinance Code. A description of the category is noted below.

2. Does the proposed rezoning further the goals, objectives and policies of the <u>2030</u> Comprehensive Plan?

This proposed rezoning is consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, and furthers the following goals, objectives and policies contained herein, including:

Future Land Use Element

Objective 3.2

Continue to promote and sustain the viability of existing and emerging commercial and industrial areas in order to achieve an integrated land use fabric which will offer a full range of employment, shopping, and leisure opportunities to support the City's residential areas.

The proposed rezoning to IL will continue to promote the viability of the commercial/industrial corridor of Lane Avenue North.

Industrial Zones

The subject property is located within the "Industrial Situational Compatibility" Zone. "Industrial Sanctuary" and "Industrial Situational Compatibility" Zones are areas identified on the Industrial Preservation Map (Map L-23) of the Future Land Use Map series of the Future Land Use Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan as strategically located industrial lands for future industrial expansion and economic development.

Policy 3.2.29

The City shall continue to update its comprehensive inventory and mapping of Industrial lands to identify and protect existing strategically located industrial lands for future expansion and economic development. These areas are crucial to the long term economic well-being of the City and are identified on the Industrial Preservation Map (Map L-23) as "Industrial Sanctuary" or "Areas of Situational Compatibility".

Policy 3.2.30

The area shown on the Industrial Preservation Map (Map L-23) as "Industrial Sanctuary" or "Areas of Situational Compatibility" are presumed to be appropriate for land use map amendments to industrial categories, subject to a case-by-case review of consistency with State and regional plans and the Comprehensive Plan.

3. Does the proposed rezoning conflict with any portion of the City's land use regulations?

No. The proposed rezoning is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use regulations. If approved as recommended by the Staff of the Planning and Development Department, the subject property will be rezoned from IBP to IL in order to allow for Industrial Light uses.

SURROUNDING LAND USE AND ZONING

The subject site is located on the North side of Muriel Street, a local roadway, which dead-ends off of Lane Avenue North, classified as a collector roadway. Muriel Street is primarily developed with single family dwellings and several vacant properties with north of the subject property being zoned Industrial Light and Industrial Heavy. The adjacent land use categories and zoning districts are as follows:

North	LI	IL	Manufacturing Heavy
South	LDR	RLD-60	Single Family Dwellings
East	LDR	RLD-60	Single Family Dwelling
West	CVS	CVS	Wetlands

It is the opinion of the Planning and Development Department that the requested rezoning to IL will be consistent and compatible with the surrounding uses.


SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

Upon visual inspection of the subject property on **June 21, 2022** by the Planning and Development Department, the required Notice of Public Hearing sign <u>was</u> posted.




RECOMMENDATION


