5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$2,773,762.00 FROM
6 THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE FUND
7 PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.470, *ORDINANCE CODE*,
8 ALLOCATING \$1,359,143.38 TO THE NEIGHBORHOODS
9 DEPARTMENT, MUNICIPAL CODE COMPLIANCE DIVISION,
10 AND THE BALANCE OF \$1,414,618.62 TO THE PUBLIC
11 WORKS DEPARTMENT, MOWING AND LANDSCAPE
12 MAINTENANCE DIVISION TO BE SPLIT BETWEEN MOWING
13 AND LANDSCAPE - PRIVATE PROPERTY (\$990,233.00)
14 AND MOWING AND LANDSCAPE - TREE REMOVAL
15 (\$424,385.62), TO PROCURE NUISANCE ABATEMENT
16 CONTRACTUAL SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF PROPERTY
17 CODE VIOLATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY IN
18 COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 518, *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS
19 INITIATED BY B.T. 22-107; AMENDING SECTION
20 111.470 (NUISANCE ABATEMENT LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE
21 FUND), PART 4 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL AND
22 CODE REGULATION), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE
23 AND TRUST ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO PROVIDE
24 THAT FUNDS DEPOSITED IN THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT
25 LIEN SPECIAL REVENUE FUND SHALL BE SELF-
26 APPROPRIATING AND DESIGNATING HOW FUNDS SHALL BE
27 DIVIDED BETWEEN THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT AND
28 THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF
29 FUNDING THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES; PROVIDING
30 CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN
31 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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2 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

3 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
4 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
5 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
6 listed in subsection (b):

13 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

14 The funding above comprises available revenues from the
15 Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund pursuant to
16 Section 111.470, *Ordinance Code*, that will be used for
17 nuisance abatement contractual services.

18 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
19 Section 1 is to provide funding for nuisance abatement contractual
20 services for the removal of property code violations throughout the
21 city in accordance with Chapter 518, *Ordinance Code*. A total of
22 \$1,359,143.38 is allocated to the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal
23 Code Compliance Division, and the remaining \$1,414,618.62 is
24 allocated to the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape
25 Maintenance Division to be split between Mowing and Landscape -
26 Private Property (\$990,233.00) and Mowing and Landscape - Tree Removal
27 (\$424,385.62), for the procurement of these contractual services.

28 **Section 3. Amending Section 111.470 (Nuisance Abatement**
29 **Lien Special Revenue Fund), Part 4 (Administration, Personnel and**
30 **Code Regulation), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts),**
31 **Ordinance Code.** Section 111.470 (Nuisance Abatement Lien Special

1 Revenue Fund), Part 4 (Administration, Personnel and Code
2 Regulations), Chapter 111 (Special Revenue and Trust Accounts),
3 *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 **CHAPTER 111 - SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST ACCOUNTS**

6 **PART 4. - ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL AND CODE REGULATION**

8 **Sec. 111.470. - Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund.**

9 There is hereby created the Nuisance Abatement Lien Special
10 Revenue Fund, a permanent fund of the City within the Neighborhoods
11 Department, into which monies derived from the collection of liens
12 pursuant to Sections 518.211 (payment and enforcement of lien and
13 interest thereon), 518.308 (demolition liens), and 91.107 and 91.112
14 (administrative liens), *Ordinance Code*, and other civil penalties
15 collected pursuant to the citation and enforcement authority
16 contained in Part 2 of Chapter 518, *Ordinance Code*, resulting from
17 the City's prosecution of nuisances, shall be deposited from time-
18 to-time. ~~Disbursements from this fund by Council shall be limited to~~
19 ~~funding the abatement of nuisances.~~ Such monies as are deposited in
20 this fund are to be self-appropriating and shall be divided amongst
21 the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal Code Compliance Division
22 (49%), and the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape
23 Maintenance Division (51%), and shall be used solely for the purpose
24 of funding the abatement of nuisances. The monies deposited in this
25 fund shall not lapse at the end of any fiscal year and shall remain
26 available for expenditure for the purposes set forth herein.

27 **Section 4. Codification Instructions.** The Codifier and the
28 Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and
29 division "table of contents" consistent with the changes set forth
30 herein, including renumbering of sections. Such editorial changes
31 and any other changes necessary to make the *Ordinance Code* consistent

1 with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein,
2 and the changes to the *Ordinance Code* shall be made forthwith and
3 when inconsistencies are discovered.

4 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall
5 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
6 effective without the Mayor's signature.
