Section 2. For fiscal year 2022-2023 the nonrecurring sum 14 15 of \$2,500,000 from the General Revenue Fund is appropriated to 16 the Department of Financial Services to fund the Jacksonville 17 Fire and Rescue Department Health and Wellness Center as 18 described in Appropriations Project Request 716. 19 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
