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ORDINANCE 2022-578-E

AN ORDINANCE FINDING THAT THE PROPOSED FACILITY RELOCATION AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS TO JACKSONVILLE FAIRGROUNDS ADJACENT TO THE CITY'S EQUESTRIAN CENTER AT CECIL COMMERCE CENTER PROPOSED BY THE GREATER **JACKSONVILLE** AGRICULTURAL FAIR ASSOCIATION SHALL SERVE A PUBLIC PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON SAID PROPOSED FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS OF THE FAIRGROUNDS; JACKSONVILLE PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair Association (Jacksonville Fair) is proposing to relocate its campus from its current constrained site in downtown Jacksonville to a larger and more appropriate site on the west side of Jacksonville adjacent to the City's Equestrian Center at the Cecil Commerce Center; and

whereas, the new multi-million dollar fair campus will provide much more space for larger and improved educational exhibits, better vehicle access and parking for exhibitors and visitors, and more and better space for the housing and exhibition of the livestock that are such an important part of the fair experience; and

WHEREAS, to help fund the relocation, the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair Association is applying for a grant through the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services agriculture education and promotion grant program pursuant to Section 288.1175, Florida Statutes, in the amount of \$3 million dollars; and

WHEREAS, the new, relocated Facility will be situated on Cityowned property (RE Number 002254-0010) with other similar Cityowned uses such as the Equestrian Center, on the westside of Jacksonville, within the City of Jacksonville, in Council District 12; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville is extremely supportive of the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair Association's proposed new facility, will be supporting it with a substantial City financial contribution, and wishes to support the Fair's application for state funding for this most worthwhile project;

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to make certain findings, after holding a public hearing as required by Section 288.1175, Florida Statutes, that the facility improvements from the relocation of the Jacksonville Fair serve a public purpose of such expenditure and to certify as such; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

- Section 1. Preamble. The recitals contained in the "whereas" provisions hereinabove are true and correct and are hereby incorporated by reference herein.
- Section 2. Findings. Based upon the information provided to the City of Jacksonville by the Greater Jacksonville Fair Association, we hereby find and certify as follows:
- a. That the proposed Facility will be located within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Jacksonville.
 - b. That the proposed Facility serves a public purpose.
- c. The Jacksonville City Council supports the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair Association and the Greater Jacksonville Fair's application for the Agriculture Education and Promotion Facility Grant and encourages the State to approve the application for funding.
- Section 3. Providing for a public hearing prior to adoption. Pursuant to Section 288.1175, Florida Statutes, a public

hearing shall be held prior to adoption of this ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
