5 AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE 2006-888-E
6 AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THE CITY'S SPECIAL
7 REVENUE BONDS, IN ONE OR MORE SERIES IN AN AMOUNT
8 NECESSARY TO PROVIDE NOT IN EXCESS OF
9 \$120,000,000 OF NET PROJECT FUNDS IN ORDER TO
10 FINANCE AND REFINANCE THE ACQUISITION AND
11 CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AND
12 IMPROVEMENTS (THE "SERIES 2022C PROJECT");
13 PROVIDING AUTHORITY FOR THIS ORDINANCE;
14 PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN DEFINITIONS; MAKING
15 CERTAIN FINDINGS; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE
16 SHALL CONSTITUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE ISSUER
17 AND THE BONDHOLDERS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
18 DETERMINE THE TERMS OF SUCH BONDS, AS PROVIDED
19 HEREIN; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD THE SALE
20 OF SAID BONDS ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS, A LIMITED
21 COMPETITIVE BASIS, A NEGOTIATED BASIS, OR AS A
22 PRIVATE PLACEMENT, AS PROVIDED HEREIN;
23 AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF DEBT SERVICE
24 RESERVE FUND PRODUCTS WITH RESPECT TO SUCH
25 BONDS, IF DEEMED NECESSARY; AUTHORIZING THE
26 ACQUISITION OF CREDIT FACILITIES WITH RESPECT TO
27 SUCH BONDS, IF DEEMED NECESSARY; AUTHORIZING
28 THE PREPARATION OF PRELIMINARY AND FINAL
29 OFFICIAL STATEMENTS AND/OR OFFERING MEMORANDA
30 WITH RESPECT TO SUCH BONDS; AUTHORIZING THE
31 EXECUTION OF A CONTINUING DISCLOSURE UNDERTAKING

1 OR AGREEMENT WITH RESPECT TO SUCH BONDS;
2 AUTHORIZING THE DESIGNATION OF A DEPUTY
3 REGISTRAR AND PAYING AGENT AND THE PROVIDERS OF
4 OTHER SERVICES WITH RESPECT TO SUCH BONDS;
5 PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICATION OF SUCH BOND
6 PROCEEDS; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A BOND
7 TERMS AGREEMENT WITH RESPECT TO SAID BONDS;
8 PROVIDING CERTAIN ADDITIONAL DETAILS AND
9 AUTHORIZATIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; WAIVING
10 THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 104.211 (PROCEDURE FOR
11 SALE OF BONDS) OF CHAPTER 104 (BONDS), *ORDINANCE*
12 *CODE*, SO AS TO ALLOW THE CITY TO AWARD THE SALE
13 OF SAID BONDS ON A LIMITED COMPETITIVE BASIS, AS
14 A NEGOTIATED SALE, OR AS A PRIVATE PLACEMENT;
15 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Jacksonville, Florida
18 (the "Council") previously enacted Ordinance 2006-888-E (as amended
19 and supplemented, including by this Supplemental Ordinance, the
20 "Special Revenue Bond Ordinance") providing for the issuance of bonds
21 known as "Special Revenue Bonds" of the City of Jacksonville, Florida
22 (the "Issuer") to be paid from Covenant Revenues of the Issuer
23 budgeted and appropriated as provided in the Special Revenue Bond
24 Ordinance and deposited into the funds and accounts created
25 thereunder, all in the manner provided in the Special Revenue Bond
26 Ordinance; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the Issuer initially financed certain capital
28 improvements through its commercial paper program, which provides
29 short term financing; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Issuer's Financial Advisor has recommended and the
2 Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Issuer
3 to authorize the issuance of Additional Bonds under the Special
4 Revenue Bond Ordinance as supplemented hereby in order to finance and
5 refinance the acquisition and construction of certain capital
6 equipment and improvements for the Issuer, and pay the costs of
7 issuance related thereto, all as more particularly described in
8 **Exhibit 1**, attached hereto, as the same may be supplemented from time
9 to time; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Section 12.02 of the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance
11 provides for the issuance of Additional Bonds under the terms,
12 limitations, and conditions provided therein and the Issuer has
13 complied with Section 12.02 of the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance or
14 will comply therewith prior to issuance of the Series 2022C Bonds,
15 to the extent required therein, and is, or will be, therefore, legally
16 entitled to issue the Series 2022C Bonds as Additional Bonds; now
17 therefore

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Authority For This Supplemental Ordinance.** This
20 Supplemental Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Act and the Special
21 Revenue Bond Ordinance.

22 **Section 2. Definitions.** All terms used herein in capitalized
23 form, unless otherwise defined herein or unless the context clearly
24 indicates some other meaning, shall have the same meaning as ascribed
25 to them in the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance. In addition, as used
26 herein, unless the context clearly indicates some other meaning:

27 "Approved Underwriters" means those approved investment banking
28 firms selected from time to time by the Issuer pursuant to its
29 selection procedures with respect to such services, who may also

1 serve as a private placement agent in the case of a private placement
2 to institutional investors.

3 "Bond Terms Agreement" shall have the meaning provided in
4 Section 14(a) hereof.

5 "Chief Financial Officer" means the Chief Financial Officer or
6 other officer of the Issuer serving as the chief financial officer
7 as defined in Section 218.403, Florida Statutes.

8 "Financial Advisor" means the individual(s) or firm(s) retained
9 by the Issuer to provide financial advisory services with respect to
10 debt issued by the Issuer.

11 "Issuer" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the recitals
12 to this Supplemental Ordinance.

13 "Mayor" means the Mayor of the Issuer or his or her designee or
14 alternative officer authorized by ordinance of the Issuer or executive
15 order.

16 "Series 2022C Bonds" means the Additional Bonds authorized
17 hereunder to be issued, from time to time, in one or more Series to
18 finance the Series 2022C Project.

19 "Series 2022C Project" means certain capital equipment and
20 improvements for the Issuer, all as more particularly described in
21 **Exhibit 1**, attached hereto, as the same may be supplemented by a Bond
22 Terms Agreement from time to time, and includes capital equipment and
23 improvements previously financed through the Issuer's commercial
24 paper program.

25 "Special Revenue Bond Ordinance" shall have the meaning ascribed
26 thereto in the recitals to this Supplemental Ordinance.

27 "Supplemental Ordinance" means this ordinance supplementing the
28 Special Revenue Bond Ordinance.

1 **Section 3. Findings.**

2 (a) The Issuer previously enacted the Special Revenue Bond
3 Ordinance providing for the issuance of Bonds to be paid from Covenant
4 Revenues of the Issuer budgeted and appropriated as provided in the
5 Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and deposited into the funds and
6 accounts created thereunder, all in the manner provided in the Special
7 Revenue Bond Ordinance.

8 (b) The findings and declarations of the Issuer in the Special
9 Revenue Bond Ordinance are hereby expressly approved, ratified, and
10 confirmed.

11 (c) The improvements comprising the Series 2022C Project have
12 been previously authorized by the Issuer and a portion have been
13 initially financed through the Issuer's commercial paper program.
14 Based on the advice of the Issuer's Financial Advisor, the Issuer has
15 determined that it is desirable and in the best interests of the
16 Issuer to finance and refinance the Series 2022C Project by the
17 issuance of the Series 2022C Bonds.

18 (d) The Issuer is authorized by the Act, the Special Revenue
19 Bond Ordinance, and this Supplemental Ordinance to issue the Series
20 2022C Bonds, from time to time, in one or more Series to finance and
21 refinance the Series 2022C Project and to pay the costs of issuance
22 thereof.

23 (e) Upon issuance, in accordance with the terms hereof, the
24 Series 2022C Bonds shall constitute Additional Bonds under the Special
25 Revenue Bond Ordinance, entitled to all of the security and benefits
26 thereof.

27 (f) It is estimated that the Covenant Revenues available to be
28 budgeted and appropriated as provided in the Special Revenue Bond
29 Ordinance will be sufficient to pay all principal of and interest on
30 the Series 2022C Bonds to be issued hereunder, and all other Bonds

1 and Additional Bonds issued under the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance,
2 as the same become due and payable, and to make all sinking fund,
3 reserve, and other payments in connection therewith.

4 (g) Because of the characteristics of the Series 2022C Bonds,
5 the source of security and payment thereof, prevailing and anticipated
6 market conditions, the need for flexibility in timing the issuance
7 and sale of the Series 2022C Bonds, the need to allow for a timely
8 sale of the Series 2022C Bonds together with other refunding Special
9 Revenue Bonds, advantages expected to be received from an enhanced
10 marketing of the Series 2022C Bonds afforded by engaging one or more
11 investment banking firms in a negotiated sale, or, in some market
12 conditions, a private placement to institutional investors, in
13 consultation with the Chief Financial Officer and the Issuer's
14 Financial Advisor, it is necessary and in the best interests of the
15 Issuer to waive the provisions of Section 104.211 (Procedure for Sale
16 of Bonds) of Chapter 104 (Bonds), *Ordinance Code*, and authorize the
17 sale of the Series 2022C Bonds at a limited competitive or negotiated
18 sale or sales or as a private placement to institutional investors,
19 as provided herein.

20 **Section 4. Instrument to Constitute Contract.** In
21 consideration of the acceptance of the Series 2022C Bonds authorized
22 to be issued hereunder by those who shall own the same from time to
23 time, the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance, as supplemented by this
24 Supplemental Ordinance and certain Bond Terms Agreements to be
25 delivered by the Mayor as provided in Section 14(a) hereof providing
26 the terms and details of the Series 2022C Bonds, shall be and
27 constitute a contract between the Issuer and the registered owners
28 of the Series 2022C Bonds. The covenants and agreements set forth
29 herein, in such Bond Terms Agreements and in the Special Revenue Bond
30 Ordinance, to be performed by the Issuer shall be for the equal

1 benefit, protection, and security of the registered owners of the
2 Series 2022C Bonds, and the Series 2022C Bonds shall constitute Bonds
3 under the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and shall be of equal rank
4 with all other Series 2022C Bonds and with all other Bonds from time
5 to time Outstanding under the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance, without
6 preference, priority, or distinction over any other thereof except
7 as may be expressly provided herein or in the Special Revenue Bond
8 Ordinance. All covenants in the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance shall
9 be fully applicable to the Series 2022C Bonds.

10 **Section 5. Authorization of Financing and Refinancing the**
11 **Series 2022C Project.** The financing and refinancing of the Series
12 2022C Project is hereby authorized and approved. Any portion of the
13 Series 2022C Project not otherwise financed by the issuance of Series
14 2022C Bonds may, as determined by the Mayor in consultation with the
15 Chief Financial Officer and the Issuer's Financial Advisor, be
16 financed or refinanced through the City's Commercial Paper Program.

17 **Section 6. Authorization and Terms of the Series 2022C Bonds.**

18 (a) Subject and pursuant to the provisions hereof, particularly
19 the provisions of Section 5 above, and of the Special Revenue Bond
20 Ordinance, Additional Bonds to be known as the "City of Jacksonville,
21 Florida Special Revenue Bonds, Series 2022C" (or if such Series 2022C
22 Bonds are issued in more than one Series, or are not issued in
23 calendar year 2022, such other name or series designation as the
24 Mayor shall direct) are hereby authorized to be issued in one or more
25 Series and in the original aggregate principal amount necessary to
26 provide not in excess of \$120,000,000 of net funds available for the
27 financing and refinancing of the Series 2022C Project (exclusive of
28 costs of issuance and the funding of any reserves), provided all
29 limitations and other delegation criteria provided herein have been

1 met. The Series 2022C Bonds may be issued together with other Special
2 Revenue Bonds or Special Revenue Refunding Bonds of the Issuer.

3 (b) The Series 2022C Bonds of each Series or installment shall
4 finally mature, taking into account any subsequent roll-overs and
5 refundings of any Series 2022C Bonds issued as Designated Maturity
6 Debt, not later than thirty-one years from the date of original
7 issuance and delivery of each such Series or installment of Series
8 2022C Bonds. Subject to such maturity limitation, the Mayor is hereby
9 authorized to determine the dates of maturity of the Series 2022C
10 Bonds and, as applicable, designate all or a portion thereof as
11 Designated Maturity Debt for purposes of the Special Revenue Bond
12 Ordinance. Such determination by the Mayor shall be based upon his
13 determination, in consultation with the Chief Financial Officer and
14 the Issuer's Financial Advisor, existing and anticipated market
15 conditions and the Issuer's debt profile, that the debt structure is
16 in the best financial interests of the Issuer. The authorization
17 provided herein shall include the authorization to refund and rollover
18 Series 2022C Bonds issued as Designated Maturity Debt from time to
19 time, provided that such maturity limit and the other delegation
20 criteria provided herein shall apply to such refundings and rollovers.

21 (c) The Series 2022C Bonds shall bear such interest rate or
22 rates, not to exceed the maximum rates permitted by applicable law
23 and the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance, as shall be determined by the
24 Mayor in the applicable Bond Terms Agreement and as shall comply with
25 the Issuer's Debt Management Policy. Such determination by the Mayor
26 shall be based upon his determination, in consultation with the Chief
27 Financial Officer and the Issuer's Financial Advisor, existing and
28 anticipated market conditions, the Issuer's debt profile, the
29 Issuer's Debt Management Policy and the terms and conditions of the
30 Special Revenue Bond Ordinance, that such rate or rates are in the

1 best financial interests of the Issuer. In establishing fixed
2 interest rates, the Mayor shall rely on the opinion of the Issuer's
3 Financial Advisor that such rate or rates are fair and reasonable
4 based upon existing and anticipated market conditions. Such interest
5 rate or rates may be fixed rates, adjustable rates, or variable rates,
6 including without limitation, variable rates determined by reference
7 to a percentage of an index or of a benchmark or reference interest
8 rate and may include such adjustments as the Mayor shall deem fair
9 and reasonable in reliance upon the opinion of the Issuer's Financial
10 Advisor that such rates and adjustments are fair and reasonable based
11 upon existing and anticipated market conditions, or daily, weekly or
12 term interest rates which are reset periodically by a remarketing
13 agent, generally as the minimum rate or rates as will, in the
14 reasonable judgment of such remarketing agent, allow such Series
15 2022C Bonds to be remarketed at par. The Mayor is hereby authorized
16 to determine term rate periods for any Series 2022C Bonds bearing
17 interest at term rates.

18 (d) The Series 2022C Bonds may be issued as current interest
19 paying bonds, Serial Bonds, Term Bonds, and/or Designated Maturity
20 Debt, as determined by the Mayor. The Mayor is hereby authorized to
21 determine the dated date or dates, interest payment dates, the
22 authorized denominations, the provisions with respect to registration
23 and transfer, the medium of payment, the place or places of payment,
24 the optional and mandatory redemption terms and conditions (including
25 notice requirements), if any, optional and mandatory tender for
26 purchase provisions, terms and conditions, if any, and such other
27 terms and conditions with respect to the Series 2022C Bonds as shall
28 be consistent with the Issuer's Debt Management Policy, the provisions
29 of the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and this Supplemental Ordinance,
30 all as may be specified in the applicable Bond Terms Agreement. Such

1 determination by the Mayor shall be based upon the Mayor's
2 determination, in consultation with the Chief Financial Officer and
3 the Issuer's Financial Advisor, as to whether such provisions, terms
4 and conditions are fair and reasonable and comply with market norms,
5 and that the provisions, terms and conditions with respect to the
6 Series 2022C Bonds are in the best financial interest of the Issuer.
7 Any installment or maturity of Series 2022C Bonds determined by the
8 Mayor to be issued as Designated Maturity Debt is hereby designated
9 as "Designated Maturity Debt" for purposes of the Special Revenue
10 Bond Ordinance. An amount in each Bond Year equal to the principal
11 amount of Series 2022C Bonds required to be redeemed in such Bond
12 Year prior to and including the maturity thereof pursuant to mandatory
13 sinking fund redemptions as designated by the Mayor pursuant hereto
14 are hereby designated as "Amortization Installments" as that term is
15 defined in the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance. The Issuer may satisfy
16 its obligations to make Amortization Installments with respect to the
17 Series 2022C Bonds, on or before the 45th day next preceding each
18 principal payment date on which Series 2022C Bonds are to be retired
19 pursuant to Amortization Installments by delivering to the Deputy
20 Registrar and Paying Agent for cancellation, Series 2022C Bonds that
21 are Term Bonds of the maturity required to be redeemed on such
22 principal payment date in any aggregate principal amount desired.
23 Upon such delivery, the Issuer shall receive a credit against the
24 amounts required to be deposited in the Debt Service Account on
25 account of such Term Bonds in an amount equal to 100% of the principal
26 amount of any of the Term Bonds so purchased and cancelled.

27 **Section 7. Sale of Series 2022C Bonds.** The Mayor is hereby
28 authorized to award the sale of the Series 2022C Bonds, in one or
29 more Series or installments and from time to time as necessary to
30 finance and refinance the Series 2022C Project, pursuant to a

1 competitive, limited competitive or negotiated sale or sales to one
2 or more of the Approved Underwriters or as determined by the Mayor,
3 or to place the Series 2022C Bonds, or one or more installments
4 thereof, with one or more institutional investors. As a point of
5 clarification, the term institutional investors shall include, but
6 not be limited to, banking institutions. For a competitive sale, the
7 Series 2022C Bonds shall be awarded to the bidder offering to purchase
8 the Series 2022C Bonds at the lowest true interest cost as calculated
9 pursuant to the official notice of bond sale. The Mayor is hereby
10 authorized to execute and deliver any documents necessary to evidence
11 such award. In the event the Mayor determines, in consultation with
12 the Chief Financial Officer and the Issuer's Financial Advisor that
13 a limited competitive sale is in the best interests of the Issuer,
14 the Series 2022C Bonds shall be sold pursuant to a limited competitive
15 bidding process providing for competitive bids by pre-qualified
16 members of the Issuer's investment banking team and the sale of any
17 such Series 2022C Bonds shall be awarded to the bidder whose bid
18 produces the lowest true interest cost for the applicable term. In
19 the event the Mayor determines, in consultation with the Chief
20 Financial Officer and the Issuer's Financial Advisor, that a
21 negotiated sale or placement is in the best interests of the Issuer,
22 such sale or sales may be at prices and terms negotiated with one or
23 more of the Approved Underwriters or directly with an institutional
24 investor, determined in consultation with the Chief Financial Officer
25 and the Issuer's Financial Advisor that such prices and terms are
26 fair and reasonable based upon existing and anticipated market
27 conditions.

28 In connection with the sale of the Series 2022C Bonds, the Mayor
29 may execute and deliver and the Corporation Secretary shall attest
30 the execution of all necessary documents and agreements including one

1 or more bond purchase agreements with one or more of the Approved
2 Underwriters, or commitment letters or agreements with the
3 institutional investor or investors purchasing the Series 2022C
4 Bonds, in forms approved by the Office of General Counsel, with such
5 terms and conditions as shall be consistent with the terms of the
6 Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and this Supplemental Ordinance and
7 shall be in accordance with market norms. The Approved Underwriters
8 or institutional investors to whom the Series 2022C Bonds are sold,
9 or with whom they are placed, shall provide (i) a disclosure statement
10 regarding each such Series 2022C Bonds containing the information
11 required pursuant to Section 218.385(6), Florida Statutes, and (ii)
12 a Truth-In-Bonding Statement pursuant to Section 218.385(2), Florida
13 Statutes.

14 **Section 8. Series 2022C Bonds Reserve Requirement.** The Mayor,
15 in consultation with the Chief Financial Officer and the Issuer's
16 Financial Advisor, shall determine the Reserve Requirement, if any,
17 with respect to the Series 2022C Bonds and shall designate whether
18 or not the Series 2022C Bonds shall be secured by the Composite
19 Reserve Subaccount.

20 The Mayor is hereby authorized to bid, award and negotiate the
21 terms and provide for the acquisition of one or more Reserve Products
22 to fund all or a portion of the Reserve Requirement, if any, with
23 respect to the Series 2022C Bonds, consistent with the requirements
24 of the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and as shall be recommended by
25 the Chief Financial Officer and the Issuer's Financial Advisor to be
26 in the best financial interests of the Issuer. The Mayor may execute
27 and deliver and the Corporation Secretary shall attest the execution
28 of such agreements (including one or more Bond Terms Agreement)
29 providing for the issuance of a Reserve Product acquired pursuant to
30 the foregoing authorization and providing such terms and agreements

1 with respect thereto, which shall be supplemental to the terms of the
2 Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and this Supplemental Ordinance, as
3 the Mayor shall approve and as shall be consistent with the provisions
4 of the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and this Supplemental Ordinance.
5 Any such agreements shall be in a form approved by the Office of
6 General Counsel.

7 **Section 9. Bond Insurance Policy; Credit Facility.** The Mayor
8 is hereby authorized to award and negotiate the terms and provide for
9 the acquisition of one or more Bond Insurance Policies and/or Credit
10 Facilities to provide credit and/or liquidity enhancement with
11 respect to all or a portion of the Series 2022C Bonds, as shall be
12 consistent with the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and recommended
13 by the Chief Financial Officer and the Issuer's Financial Advisor to
14 be in the best financial interests of the Issuer. The Mayor may
15 execute and deliver and the Corporation Secretary shall attest the
16 execution of all documents and agreements (including one or more Bond
17 Terms Agreement) providing for the issuance of a Bond Insurance Policy
18 or Credit Facility acquired pursuant to the foregoing authorization
19 and providing such terms and agreements with respect thereto, which
20 shall be supplemental to the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and this
21 Supplemental Ordinance, as the Mayor shall approve and as shall be
22 consistent with the provisions of the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance
23 and this Supplemental Ordinance. Such documents and agreements may
24 provide that Series 2022C Bonds acquired pursuant to a drawing under
25 such Credit Facility or other reimbursement obligations with respect
26 to draws or advances under any such Bond Insurance Policy or Credit
27 Facility may bear interest at the rate or rates specified therein,
28 not to exceed the maximum rate permitted by applicable law.

1 **Section 10. Official Statements.**

2 (a) The Issuer hereby authorizes the preparation of a
3 Preliminary Official Statement and/or Placement Memorandum of the
4 Issuer with respect to the Series 2022C Bonds to be sold as authorized
5 herein, providing fair and accurate disclosure with respect to the
6 Series 2022C Bonds, the terms, security and source of payment therefor
7 and other relevant matters with respect thereto. The Mayor, upon the
8 advice of the Chief Financial Officer and the Office of General
9 Counsel, is hereby authorized to approve the form and content of each
10 such Preliminary Official Statement and/or Placement Memorandum and
11 to approve and authorize the distribution thereof to prospective
12 purchasers of the Series 2022C Bonds. The Mayor and the Chief
13 Financial Officer are each individually authorized, on behalf of the
14 Issuer, to deem each such Preliminary Official Statement and/or
15 Placement Memorandum "final", for purposes of Rule 15c2-12 of the
16 Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Rule"), subject to permitted
17 omissions under the Rule.

18 (b) The Issuer hereby authorizes the preparation and
19 distribution of a final Official Statement and/or Placement
20 Memorandum with respect to Series 2022C Bonds sold or to be sold as
21 authorized herein, providing fair and accurate disclosure with
22 respect to such Series 2022C Bonds, the terms, security and sources
23 of payment thereof and other relevant matters with respect thereto.
24 The Mayor, upon the advice of the Chief Financial Officer and the
25 Office of General Counsel, is hereby authorized to approve the form
26 and content of each such Official Statement and/or Placement
27 Memorandum and authorize and approve the distribution thereof in
28 connection with the issuance and sale and/or placement of the Series
29 2022C Bonds. Such Official Statement and/or Placement Memorandum
30 shall be executed on behalf of the Issuer by the Mayor and the Chief

1 Financial Officer. Execution and delivery of each such Official
2 Statement and/or Placement Memorandum shall be conclusive evidence
3 of approval thereof pursuant hereto.

4 **Section 11. Continuing Disclosure.** In order to assist the
5 Approved Underwriters in complying with the provisions of the Rule
6 requiring continuing disclosure with respect to the Series 2022C
7 Bonds, the Issuer hereby approves and authorizes the execution and
8 delivery of one or more continuing disclosure undertakings or
9 agreements with a dissemination agent in compliance with the Rule in
10 such form as shall be approved by the Mayor upon the advice of the
11 Chief Financial Officer and the Office of General Counsel. The Mayor
12 and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and
13 deliver each such continuing disclosure instrument, execution and
14 delivery thereof to be conclusive evidence of the approval thereof
15 pursuant hereto.

16 **Section 12. Agents and Services With Respect To Series 2022C**
17 **Bonds.** The selection and appointment of the Deputy Registrar and
18 Paying Agent, any escrow agents, verification agents, electronic
19 bidding platforms, the printers for Series 2022C Bonds and/or
20 preliminary and final official statements and services for the
21 electronic distribution thereof, and similar services with respect
22 to the Series 2022C Bonds, in accordance with the Issuer's existing
23 contracts or procedures for selection of providers of such services,
24 but without further Council approval under Part 3 of Section 126 of
25 the Ordinance Code, are hereby authorized and approved.

26 **Section 13. Application Of Proceeds Of Series 2022C Bonds.**
27 Proceeds from the sale of the Series 2022C Bonds shall be applied to
28 the financing and refinancing of the Series 2022C Project, the costs
29 of issuance thereof, including the funding of any reserves, in

1 accordance with the Code and as set forth in the applicable Bond
2 Terms Agreement.

3 **Section 14. Agreements With Respect To Series 2022C Bonds.**

4 (a) In order to implement the authorizations provided in this
5 Supplemental Ordinance and the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and to
6 specify the terms and details of the Series 2022C Bonds as
7 contemplated and authorized hereby, the Mayor and the Corporation
8 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver one or more
9 certificates or agreements (referred to herein as a "Bond Terms
10 Agreement") providing the details and terms of the Series 2022C Bonds
11 in accordance with the authorizations provided herein and in a manner
12 consistent with the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and this
13 Supplemental Ordinance. Such Bond Terms Agreements shall specify the
14 authorized amounts, details, terms and conditions of the Series 2022C
15 Bonds, including all other terms and provisions specified in Section
16 6.02 of the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance, may provide for the
17 creation of such funds, accounts and subaccounts, whether or not
18 within the funds and accounts established pursuant to the Special
19 Revenue Bond Ordinance, as shall be necessary or appropriate to
20 implement and administer the Series 2022C Bonds, including, without
21 limitation, remarketing proceeds and credit and liquidity facility
22 proceeds accounts and subaccounts, and may provide such revisions to
23 the form of the Bonds provided in Section 6.09 of the Special Revenue
24 Bond Ordinance as shall be appropriate to reflect the terms of the
25 Series 2022C Bonds. Such Bond Terms Agreements shall be in such form
26 as shall be approved by the Mayor upon the advice of the Chief
27 Financial Officer and the Office of General Counsel, execution and
28 delivery thereof to be conclusive evidence of such approval. Such
29 Bond Terms Agreements shall supplement the terms and provisions of
30 the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and this Supplemental Ordinance

1 and shall be deemed to be part of the contract between the Issuer and
2 the Bondholders of the Series 2022C Bonds.

3 (b) The Mayor and Corporation Secretary are authorized to
4 execute and deliver such agreements and documents as shall be
5 necessary or appropriate to provide for the sale, issuance and
6 administration of each Series 2022C Bonds in a manner consistent with
7 the Special Revenue Bond Ordinance and the authorizations provided
8 in this Supplemental Ordinance, including, without limitation, Bond
9 Terms Agreements, commitment letters or agreements, bond purchase
10 agreements, remarketing agreements, escrow agreements, broker-dealer
11 agreements, registrar and paying agent agreements, credit and
12 liquidity facility reimbursement agreements, bond insurance and
13 Reserve Product agreements. Such documents and agreements shall be
14 in such form approved by the Mayor upon the advice of the Chief
15 Financial Officer and the Office of General Counsel, execution and
16 delivery thereof to be conclusive evidence of such approval.

17 **Section 15. Authorizations.**

18 (a) The Mayor and the Corporation Secretary or their duly
19 authorized alternative officers are hereby authorized and directed
20 on behalf of the Issuer to execute the Series 2022C Bonds (including
21 any temporary Series 2022C Bonds) as provided in the Special Revenue
22 Bond Ordinance and any of such officers is hereby authorized and
23 directed upon execution of the Series 2022C Bonds in substantially
24 the form provided herein (or in the applicable Bond Terms Agreement)
25 to deliver the Series 2022C Bonds in the amounts authorized hereunder
26 to the Deputy Registrar and Paying Agent for authentication and
27 delivery to or upon the order of one or more of the Approved
28 Underwriters or purchaser thereof upon payment of the purchase price
29 therefor.

1 (b) The Mayor, the Corporation Secretary of the Issuer, the
2 Chief Financial Officer and the General Counsel and such other
3 officers and employees of the Issuer as may be designated by the
4 Mayor are each designated as agents of the Issuer in connection with
5 the issuance and delivery of the Series 2022C Bonds and are authorized
6 and empowered, collectively and individually, to take all action and
7 steps, conduct such hearings, and to execute all instruments,
8 documents and contracts on behalf of the Issuer that are necessary
9 or desirable in connection with the financing and refinancing of the
10 Series 2022C Project and the sale, execution and delivery of the
11 Series 2022C Bonds and which are specifically authorized or are not
12 inconsistent with the terms and provisions of the Special Revenue
13 Bond Ordinance, this Supplemental Ordinance and the applicable Bond
14 Terms Agreement. Such officers and those so designated are hereby
15 charged with the responsibility for the issuance of the Series 2022C
16 Bonds and the financing and refinancing of the Series 2022C Project.

17 (c) It is the intent of the Council that the Special Revenue
18 Bond Ordinance and this Supplemental Ordinance (together with the
19 applicable Bond Terms Agreement) shall constitute full and complete
20 authorization and approval of the issuance of the Series 2022C Bonds
21 for the purposes and on the terms and conditions provided herein and
22 that no further action of the Council shall be required with respect
23 thereto.

24 **Section 16. Waiver of Section 104.211, Ordinance Code,**
25 **Authorized.** The provisions of Section 104.211 (Procedure for Sale
26 of Bonds) of Chapter 104 (Bonds), *Ordinance Code*, are hereby waived
27 so as to allow for the Issuer to award the sale of the Series 2022C
28 Bonds on a limited competitive basis, on a negotiated basis or as a
29 private placement to institutional investors rather than on a
30 competitive basis. This waiver is necessary because of the need for

1 flexibility in timing the issuance and sale of the Series 2022C Bonds,
2 the need to allow for a timely sale of the Series 2022C Bonds together
3 with other refunding Special Revenue Bonds, advantages expected to
4 be received from an enhanced marketing of the Series 2022C Bonds
5 afforded by engaging one or more investment banking firms in a limited
6 competitive sale, a negotiated sale, or a private placement to
7 institutional investors, and in consultation with the Chief Financial
8 Officer and the Issuer's Financial Advisor.

9 **Section 17. Effective Date.** This Supplemental Ordinance shall
10 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
11 effective without the Mayor's signature.
