Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 5 Section 2. Section 1 is to provide funding for the 2021-2022 portion of the 6 7 ongoing health services contract between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Department of Health in Duval County ("DOH"). The funds 8 9 being appropriated in this legislation were originally appropriated 10 in fiscal year 2020-2021 by Ordinance 2021-149-E but were recaptured to the general fund at the beginning of fiscal year 2021-2022 due to 11 a lack of carryover language in the initial appropriation. 12 The ongoing COVID-19 response efforts that were the subject of Ordinance 13 14 2021-149-E were paid in error using the funds appropriated in the FY 2021-2022 budget for the DOH's 2021-2022 contract due to the funding 15 16 being in the same account. This appropriation is necessary to pay the DOH for the remainder of the FY 2021-2022 contract. 17

18 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this 19 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2022-20 2023.

21 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 23 without the Mayor's signature.
