AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4,294.00 FROM A DESIGNATED SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY TΟ PROVIDE FUNDING FOR FIRST COAST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO PROVIDE MEALS AND HEALTH SERVICES TO VULNERABLE RESIDENTS; REQUESTING CARRYOVER; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FIRST COAST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO EFFECTUATE THIS LEGISLATION; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G)(EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGUALTIONS), CHAPTER 126, ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING SECTION 118.201(F)(7) (RELEASE OF APPROPRIATIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE ANY OR ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS LEGISLATION; DESIGNATING THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE TO OVERSEE THE PROJECT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,

within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

- (c) Explanation of Appropriation Transfer funding from the designated Council contingency to First Coast Community Development to provide meals and health services to vulnerable residents.
- Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 above is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to First Coast Community Development so that they can provide meals and health services to vulnerable residents.
- Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover through September 30, 2023.
- Secretary to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this legislation. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver an agreement between the City of Jacksonville and First Coast Community Development.
- Section 5. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the services of First Coast Community Development to provide for meals and health services for vulnerable residents. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is

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30 31 exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Waiver of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with First Coast Community Development and the City of Jacksonville. The City finds that First Coast Community Development is a justified direct contract because First Coast Community Development is a nonprofit organization which provides free meals and limited health services to vulnerable residents.

Section 7. Waiver of Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release of Appropriations), Ordinance Code. Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release of Appropriations), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived as to the disbursement of funds based upon draws for services performed or reimbursements for work done. Waiver of Section 118.201(f)(7), Ordinance Code, is requested to allow advance payments in excess of 10% to First Coast Community Development. Due to the nature and purpose of the funding, advance payment equal to 1/2 of the appropriation (\$2,147) will be allowed to be paid for start-up costs with the remainder paid upon completion of the project, subject to the terms of the agreement, drafted pursuant to Section 4 of this Ordinance.

Section 8. Authorizing the Mayor and the Corporation Secretary to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate

this legislation. The Mayor and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this legislation.

Section 9. Oversight Department. The Office of Grants and Contract Compliance within the Department of Finance and Administration shall oversee the project described herein.

Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant

to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Once cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that this funding is coming from a Council contingency account that will return to the General Fund if not appropriated by September 30, 2022. Emergency action is requested so that this bill can be taken up in at the last meeting in September to secure the appropriations of these funds for this purpose. Carryover language is requested below

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Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become Section 11. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
