For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 18 19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 20 listed in subsection (b): 21 (B.T. 22-115, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 22 by this reference) 23 (a) Appropriated from: \$6,000,000 24 See B.T. 22-115 25 (b) Appropriated to: \$6,000,000 26 See B.T. 22-115 27 Explanation of Appropriation: The funding above represents an appropriation of grant 2.8 29 funding in the amount of \$6,000,000 from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") 30 for the Beverly Hills East Septic Tank Phase-Out project 31

(the "Project"). No local match is required.

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Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in Purpose. Section 1 is to provide funding to construct a new central gravity sewer system and approximately 200 sewer hookups with septic tank abandonments in the Beverly Hills East area. Beverly Hills is ranked among the top three areas in Jacksonville with a priority need to phase out failing septic tanks due to its location within close proximity to impaired bodies of water. The City has identified 266 parcels in the Project area that have or could have onsite sewage treatment and disposal systems (septic tanks) that can be eliminated. The Project will entail construction of a new central gravity sewer system, including installation of sewer laterals in the rights-ofway to allow parcels with septic systems to connect to the new gravity The Project will also involve the on-site abandonment of septic systems for parcels with owner commitments and is anticipated to result in a reduction in nutrient pollution in the Ribault River. A copy of the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Standard Grant Agreement (Agreement Number: LPA0177) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect FDEP grant funding for the Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay of the Project and loss of grant funding for the Project.
