- (2) On page 1, lines 10-11, after "2022-214-E;" insert

 "ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS;

 ESTABLISHING PROCESS FOR REVIEW, EVALUATION, AND SCORING

 OF APPLICATIONS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF GRANT

 AGREEMENTS;";
- (3) On page 1, line 29, <u>strike</u> "priority populations" and <u>insert</u> "most vulnerable persons and needs categories";
- (4) On page 2, line 5½, insert new Sections 3, 4, and 5, to read as follows:
 - "Section 3. Eligibility and Application Requirements. The PSG Micro-Grant administrator shall establish the eligibility criteria and application requirements for the Micro-Grant Pilot Program, which shall be approved by the Director of Finance and Administration. Upon their approval by the Director of Finance and Administration, a copy of the eligibility criteria and application requirements shall be provided to City Council.
 - Section 4. Review, Evaluation, and Scoring of Applications. The PSG Micro-Grant administrator shall establish the process for review, evaluation, and

scoring of applications submitted for the Micro-Grant Pilot Program. The Micro-Grant Pilot Program will provide for an award of up to \$20,000 for up to 10 grantees. The PSG Micro-Grant administrator shall forward a complete list of Micro-Grant recipients and funding allocations to the Council Auditor's office, the Office of the Mayor, the City Council and the Director of the Finance and Administration Department.

Section 5. Approval and authorization to execute. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute grant agreements, including amendments thereto, in accordance with Chapter 118, Parts 1-5, Ordinance Code, with the Micro-Grant Pilot Program funding recipients identified through the competitive application process outlined in Section 4 of this Ordinance.";

- (5) Renumber remaining Sections accordingly;
- (6) On page 2, line 6, strike "The" and insert "The PSG Micro-Grant administrator position created by Ordinance 2022-234-E within the";
- (7) On **page 1, line 1,** amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
