ORDINANCE 2022-525-E

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2020B SERIES TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE FUTURE LAND USE ELEMENT (FLUE) OF THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, AMENDING FLUE POLICY 1.1.20C, CREATING A NEW FLUE OBJECTIVE 3.5 AND RELATED POLICIES ΤO ADDRESS TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT (TOD) PLANNING MASTER AND IMPLEMENTATION, AND REVISING AND ADDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has initiated 17 certain revisions and modifications to the text of the 2030 18 Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the procedures and requirements 19 set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, to facilitate the 20 appropriate and timely implementation of the plan and has provided 21 the necessary supporting data and analysis to support and justify the 22 amendments determined to be required, and accordingly, has proposed 23 certain revisions and modifications, which are more particularly set 24 forth in **Exhibit 1**, dated June 10, 2022, attached hereto and 25 incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City, by the adoption of Ordinance 2020-127-E, approved this amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan for transmittal to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), as the State Land Planning Agency, and other required state agencies, for review and comment; and

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WHEREAS, by various letters and e-mails, the DEO and other state

reviewing agencies transmitted their comments, if any, regarding this
proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department reviewed the proposed revisions, considered all comments received, prepared a written report and rendered an advisory recommendation to the Council with respect to the proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

8 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, as the Local Planning Agency, 9 held a public hearing on this proposed amendment to the 2030 10 Comprehensive Plan, with due public notice having been provided, and 11 reviewed and considered all comments received during the public 12 hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 650.408, Ordinance Code, the Land Use and Zoning Committee held a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, on this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, and has made its recommendation to the City Council; and

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes, and 19 Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, the City Council held a public 20 hearing, with public notice having been provided, on this proposed 21 amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further considered all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, including the data collection and analysis portions of this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, the recommendations of the Planning and Development Department and the Planning Commission, the final recommendations of the Land Use and Zoning Committee, and the comments, if any, of the DEO and the other state agencies; and

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its authority, the City Council has determined it necessary and desirable to adopt this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan as outlined in Exhibit 1 to preserve

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and enhance present advantages, encourage the most appropriate use of land, water and resources, consistent with public interest, overcome present deficiencies, and deal effectively with future problems that may result from the use and development of land within the City of Jacksonville; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 Section 1. Purpose and Intent. This Ordinance is adopted to carry out the purpose and intent of, and exercise the authority 8 9 set out in, the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land 10 Development Regulation Act, Sections 163.3161 through 163.3248, 11 Florida Statutes, and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, as amended. The 12 amendment modifies the Future Land Use Element (FLUE) of the 2030 13 Comprehensive Plan of the City of Jacksonville to amend FLUE Policy 14 1.1.20C, to create a new FLUE Objective 3.5 and related policies to 15 address Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) master planning and 16 implementation, and to revise and add definitions.

17 Section 2. Amendment to Comprehensive Plan. The 2030 18 Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to include the revisions to the 19 text of the Future Land Use Element from the 2020B Series, which has 20 been initiated by the Planning and Development Department, as more 21 particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, dated June 10, 2022, attached 22 hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

23 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 24 effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 25 without the Mayor's signature.
