5 **ORDINANCE 2022-503**

6 AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CALENDAR YEAR 2022 ANNUAL
7 TAXES ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN
8 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, INCLUDING ONLY URBAN
9 SERVICES DISTRICT FIVE, TO WIT: THE TOWN OF
10 BALDWIN; STATING THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE FROM THE
11 2022 ROLLED-BACK RATE; AUTHORIZING ASSESSMENT
12 AND COLLECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE
13 REVENUES GENERATED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **WHEREAS**, in 1982 the City of Jacksonville entered into an
16 Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Baldwin which established the
17 millage rate for the Town of Baldwin as a differential of not less
18 than 18.8% of the City of Jacksonville's General Services District's
19 millage rate; and

20 **WHEREAS**, this Ordinance establishes the millage rate for the
21 Town of Baldwin in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement and
22 Chapter 200, *Florida Statutes*; now therefore

23 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Ad valorem tax levy - General Services District,**
25 **including only Urban Service District 5 (The Town of Baldwin).** In
26 accordance with Chapter 200, *Florida Statutes*, and the Interlocal
27 Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Town of Baldwin,
28 for the year 2022 there are hereby levied upon all taxable real and
29 personal property located within the General Services District of the
30 city, including only the Fifth Urban Services District (the Town of
31 Baldwin), for county purposes, ad valorem taxes expressed in terms

1 of mills on each dollar of assessed taxable valuation in the amount
2 of 9.526 mills, or \$9.526 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value.

3 **Section 2. Percentage change from the rolled-back rate.**

4 The 2022 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated
5 City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services
6 District of the city, including only the Fifth Urban Services District
7 (Town of Baldwin), represents an 7.63% increase from the 2022 rolled-
8 back rate set forth in Resolution 2022-500-A, which is the amount
9 agreed upon in the Interlocal Agreement between the City of
10 Jacksonville and the Town of Baldwin.

11 **Section 3. Assessment and collection.** The Property
12 Appraiser of the county is authorized and directed to assess, and the
13 Tax Collector of the county is authorized and directed to collect,
14 pursuant to law, the ad valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance.

15 **Section 4. Use of revenues.** The revenues raised by the ad
16 valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance shall be utilized in the manner
17 and for the purposes specified in the 2022-2023 budget and
18 appropriations ordinance.

19 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Council President.
