AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$200,000 FROM THE 6 7 SPECIAL COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 2022-317-E TO THE 8 9 PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT MICRO-GRANT PROGRAM TO FUND THE PSG MICRO-GRANT PROGRAM MOST VULNERABLE 10 11 PERSONS AND NEEDS CATEGORY, AS APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-214-E; ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY 12 13 AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS; ESTABLISHING PROCESS FOR REVIEW, EVALUATION, AND SCORING OF 14 APPLICATIONS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF GRANT 15 AGREEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT; PROVIDING 16 17 FOR CARRYOVER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

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The appropriation above provides \$200,000 from the Special Council Operating Contingency established by Ordinance 2022-317-E to fund the PSG Micro-Grant Pilot Program that was included as one of the most vulnerable persons and needs categories approved by Ordinance 2022-214-E.

6 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 7 Section 1 is to provide funding to the Public Service Grant Council 8 to fund the Micro-Grant Pilot Program established in the 2022-2023 9 Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs category through Ordinance 2022-10 214-E. It was established in Ordinance 2022-214-E that funding for 11 the Micro-Grant Pilot Program would be in separate legislation.

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12 Section 3. Eligibility and Application Requirements. The 13 PSG Micro-Grant administrator shall establish the eligibility 14 criteria and application requirements for the Micro-Grant Pilot 15 Program, which shall be approved by the Director of Finance and 16 Administration. Upon their approval by the Director of Finance and 17 Administration, a copy of the eligibility criteria and application 18 requirements shall be provided to City Council.

Review, Evaluation, and Scoring of Applications. 19 Section 4. The PSG Micro-Grant administrator shall establish the process for 20 21 review, evaluation, and scoring of applications submitted for the 22 Micro-Grant Pilot Program. The Micro-Grant Pilot Program will provide 23 for an award of up to \$20,000 for up to 10 grantees. The PSG Micro-Grant administrator shall forward a complete list of Micro-Grant 24 25 recipients and funding allocations to the Council Auditor's office, 26 the Office of the Mayor, the City Council and the Director of the 27 Finance and Administration Department.

28 Section 5. Approval and authorization to execute. The 29 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby 30 authorized to negotiate and execute grant agreements, including

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1 amendments thereto, in accordance with Chapter 118, Parts 1-5, 2 Ordinance Code, with the Micro-Grant Pilot Program funding recipients 3 identified through the competitive application process outlined in 4 Section 4 of this Ordinance.

5 Section 6. Oversight Department. The PSG Micro-Grant 6 administrator position created by Ordinance 2022-234-E within the 7 Office of Grants and Contract Compliance of the Finance and 8 Administration Department shall oversee the project described herein.

9 Section 7. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this
10 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 202211 2023.

Section 8. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
