Type of Action: *Ordinance Code* amendment and one-cycle emergency passage

Bill Summary: This bill amends Section 122.202(d) (Parking Rates at Municipal Parking Lots), *Ordinance Code*. One-cycle emergency passage is requested because the existing reduced monthly parking rate for employees is set to expire on September 30, 2022 and there is funding identified in the FY 22-23 budget to extend the employee discount for an additional year.

Background Information: Since 2014, all City of Jacksonville employees and employees of the Duval County Supervisor of Elections, Duval County Property Appraiser, Duval County Tax Collector, Duval County Clerk of Court and employees of the Office of the Public Defender of the Fourth Judicial Circuit who are monthly parkers at municipal owned parking facilities operated by the Office of Public Parking have been granted a 50 percent reduced monthly parking rate for the given facility. The purpose of this legislation is to extend the employee parking discount for another year, through September 30, 2023.

Policy Impact Area: Parking Rates – Employees

Fiscal Impact: Proposed \$400,000 from Special Council Contingency to DIA/Public Parking for employee parking discount, included as enhancement in budget bill 2022-504
