Ferrosource, LLC, a New York headquartered ferrous metal procurement and distribution company proposes to establish a metal fabricating facility in Jacksonville to manufacture fabricated steel products to support their customer's needs. They have identified a vacant steel building located at 1011 Blanche Street, Jacksonville, FL 32204. Ferrosource seeks to lease initially 20,000 SF of the building and convert it into a multi-line steel fabrication facility to manufacture a variety of products desired by their customer base. The building is located within a Level 2 Distressed Area. The cost for Phase I of the project is \$2.269 million. The project will create 15 new full-time manufacturing-based jobs within 18 months at an average wage of \$58,000 plus benefits. Ferrosource has indicated that within the first five years they propose to expand and create up to 35 additional new jobs and invest another \$7.7 million. The initial annual payroll for the 15 Phase I jobs will total \$870,000 plus benefits.

The Company has indicated that the financial incentive proposed is a material factor in their selection of Jacksonville for their proposed steel fabrication facility.

To support the project the city is proposing to offer a \$100,000 Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Fund (NWJEDF) Business Infrastructure Grant (BIG) to offset a portion of the cost to reconfigure the building to support their proposed multi-line metal fabrication shop. Additionally, they propose to dedicate a portion of the 20,000 SF as a Free Trade Zone to import and store steel through the Port of Jacksonville before its fabricated into structural steel parts and rebar. The total amount of City incentive would be up to \$100,000.

The funding request for the NWJEDF BIG Grant was unanimously approved by the Northwest Economic Development Fund Advisory Board at their August 16, 2022, meeting.
