 SERVICES DISTRICT FUND BALANCE)";
- (2) On page 1, lines 10, 19, 22, and 24, <u>strike</u> "B.T. 22-114" and <u>insert</u> "Revised B.T. 22-114";
- On page 1, line 10, after "22-114;" insert "APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE RECYCLING PARTNERSHIP, INC. FOR A RECYCLING EDUCATION AND OUTREACH CAMPAIGN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024;";
- (4) On page 1, line 19, strike "Exhibit 1" and insert "Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev B.T. 22-114, September 20, 2022 Finance"";
- (5) On page 2, line 15½, <u>insert</u> a new Section 3 and 4 to read as follows:
 - " Section 3. Grant Agreement Approved. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement between the City and The Recycling Partnership, Inc., substantially in the

form placed **Exhibit 2** with the Office of Legislative Services, including such changes as herein authorized, for the purpose of implementing a recycling education and outreach campaign.

The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, including providing authorization for the City of Jacksonville to subcontract with The Recycling Partnership, Inc.'s subcontractors to carry out the certain services relative to the recycling education and outreach campaign, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor or his designee. No modification to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or the liability of the City and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval of the Office of General Counsel, and all other appropriate action required by law.

Section 4. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2023-2024.";

- (7) Remove **Exhibit 1** and replace with **Revised Exhibit 1** attached hereto, which attaches the revised B.T. 22-114 to correct account codes and source of funds;

- (8) Attach Exhibit 2, attached hereto, which attaches the Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and The Recycling Partnership, Inc. for a recycling education and outreach campaign;
- (9) On **page 1, line 1,** amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
