Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the License Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Jacksonville Motorcycle Safety Training, Inc., and any amendment exercising a renewal option to extend the term of the License for each renewal period and based on the rental schedule provided in the License. The License is for a term of one year, with two one-year renewal options. The Office of Economic Development will provide oversight.

Background Information: Jacksonville Motorcycle Safety Training, Inc holds a lease at Cecil Commerce Center for the purpose of holding motorcycle driving classes in the parking lot. The Circle B Parking Lot is not otherwise currently being used by any of the existing tenants at Cecil and the training only takes place on weekends.

Policy Impact Area: Motorcycle Safety Training - Cecil Commerce Center

Fiscal Impact: This appropriation is for a tenant to re-establish a land lease with initial annual base rent of \$200 per month, no City funds required
