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22 WHEREAS, Duane Romanello, the owner of property at 3804 Valencia 23 Road, in the Riverside/Avondale Historic District in Council District 24 14, submitted Application for Certificate of Appropriateness COA-22-25 27338, requesting to construct a one-story garage addition to a 26 contributing structure with installation of a metal roof on the 27 proposed one-story garage; and

28 WHEREAS, by Final Order dated June 10, 2022, the Jacksonville 29 Historic Preservation Commission denied Application for Certificate 30 of Appropriateness COA-22-27338, requesting to construct a one-story 31 garage addition to a contributing structure with installation of a 1 metal roof on the proposed one-story garage; and

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WHEREAS, on July 1, 2022, pursuant to Section 307.201, Ordinance Code, Duane Romanello filed a Notice of Appeal, appealing the Final Order denying Application for Certificate of Appropriateness COA-22-27338; and

6 WHEREAS, the Notice of Appeal was timely filed and the appellant

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

9 Section 1. Adoption of recommended findings and 10 conclusions. The Council has reviewed the record of proceedings for 11 the Appeal of the Final Order denying Application for Certificate of 12 Appropriateness COA-22-27338. The record of proceedings is On File 13 in the City Council Legislative Services Division and the Planning 14 and Development Department. After reviewing the record of 15 proceedings, the recommended findings and conclusions of the Land Use and Zoning Committee are hereby adopted by the Council. Based on the 16 17 competent substantial evidence in the record of proceedings, the 18 Appeal is granted, the Historic Preservation Commission Final Order denying Application for Certificate of Appropriateness COA-22-27338 19 20 is overturned, and Application for Certificate of Appropriateness 21 COA-22-27338 is approved. 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alterations to the subject contributing structure located in the
 Riverside/Avondale Historic District. This Resolution is the final
 action of the Council.
