## ORDINANCE 2022-644-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$210,620.00 ADDITIONAL STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 FROM THEFLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY THROUGH THE FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION TO SERVE VERY LOW, LOW, AND MODERATE-INCOME FAMILIES, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-105; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

- (c) Explanation of Appropriation:
  - The funding above is an appropriation of \$210,620.00 in additional State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program grant funds from Florida Department of Economic Opportunity through the Florida Housing Finance Corporation for fiscal year 2021-2022.

Section 2. Purpose. The Florida Housing Finance
Corporation provides funding to local governments as an incentive
to create partnerships that produce and preserve affordable
homeownership and multifamily housing. The SHIP program was
designed to serve very low, low, and moderate-income families.
SHIP funds may be used for emergency repairs, new construction,
rehabilitation, down payment and closing costs assistance,
acquisition of property for affordable housing, matching dollars
for federal housing grants and programs, homeownership counseling
and the Foreclosure Intervention Program. The SHIP funds
appropriated herein will fund additional forgivable loans for the
City's Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program Project (\$10,620.00)
and the City's Rental Housing Development Project (\$200,000.00) for
development of additional affordable housing. A copy of the state
of Florida SHIP 2021-2022 Payment #4 disbursements reflecting these
additional funds for Duval County is attached hereto as <b>Exhibit 2</b> .

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
