parking facilities operated by the Office of Public Parking, shall 1 be entitled to a reduced monthly parking rate, which shall be fifty 2 percent (50%) of the established, monthly parking rate for the given 3 facility through September 30, 20223. The Downtown Investment 4 Authority shall file the employee rate schedule and any subsequent 5 change to the employee rate schedule with the Council Secretary, and 6 7 such rates shall become effective upon such filing unless and until the Council enacts an ordinance to the contrary. 8

10 Section 2. Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant 11 to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this 12 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the 13 existing reduced monthly parking rate for employees is set to expire 14 on September 30, 2022 and the Council has identified funding in the 15 budget to extend the employee discount for an additional year prior 16 to the expiration date.
