5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4,294.00 FROM A SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY 6 DESIGNATED ТΟ 7 FUNDING FOR FIRST COAST COMMUNITY PROVIDE 8 DEVELOPMENT, INC. TO PROVIDE MEALS AND HEALTH 9 SERVICES TO VULNERABLE RESIDENTS; REQUESTING CARRYOVER; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND 10 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE А 11 GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND 12 13 FIRST COAST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, INC. ΤO EFFECTUATE THIS LEGISLATION; INVOKING THE 14 EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G)(EXEMPTIONS), 15 PART 1 (GENERAL REGUALTIONS), CHAPTER 126, 16 ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING SECTION 17 118.107 18 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), ORDINANCE 19 20 CODE; WAIVING SECTION 118.201(F)(7) (RELEASE OF 21 APPROPRIATIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; AUTHORIZING 22 THE MAYOR AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE ANY OR ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO 23 EFFECTUATE THIS LEGISLATION; DESIGNATING THE 24 25 OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE TO OVERSEE THE PROJECT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE 26 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 27

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

9 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** – Transfer funding from the 10 designated Council contingency to First Coast Community 11 Development, Inc. to provide meals and health services to 12 vulnerable residents.

13 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 14 Section 1 above is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville 15 to First Coast Community Development, Inc. so that they can provide 16 meals and health services to vulnerable residents.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this
Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover through September 30,
2023.

20 Section 4. Authorizing the Mayor and the Corporation 21 Secretary to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate 22 this legislation. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 23 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a grant 24 agreement between the City of Jacksonville and First Coast Community 25 Development, Inc.

Section 5. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the services of First Coast Community Development, Inc. to provide for meals and health services for vulnerable residents. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is

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exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Waiver of Section 118.107 6 (Nonprofits to 7 receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. 8 9 The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding 10 through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby 11 12 waived to allow for a direct contract with First Coast Community Development, Inc. and the City of Jacksonville. The City finds that 13 First Coast Community Development, Inc. is a justified direct contract 14 because First Coast Community Development, Inc. is a nonprofit 15 organization which provides free meals and limited health services 16 to vulnerable residents. 17

Waiver of Section 118.201(f)(7) Section 7. 18 (Release of 19 Appropriations), Ordinance Code. Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release of 20 Appropriations), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, is hereby 21 waived as to the disbursement of funds based upon draws for services 22 performed or reimbursements for work done. Waiver of Section 23 118.201(f)(7), Ordinance Code, is requested to allow advance payments 24 in excess of 10% to First Coast Community Development, Inc. Due to the nature and purpose of the funding, advance payment equal to 1/225 of the appropriation (\$2,147) will be allowed to be paid for start-26 27 up costs with the remainder paid upon completion of the project, 28 subject to the terms of the agreement, drafted pursuant to Section 4 29 of this Ordinance.

30 Section 8. Oversight Department. The Office of Grants and 31 Contract Compliance within the Department of Finance and

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1 Administration shall oversee the project described herein.

2 Section 9. Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant 3 to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Once cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that this 4 funding is coming from a Council contingency account that will return 5 to the General Fund if not appropriated by September 30, 2022. 6 7 Emergency action is requested so that this bill can be taken up at the last meeting in September to secure the appropriation of these 8 9 funds for this purpose. Carryover language is requested so that First 10 Coast Community Development, Inc. has time to expend the funds appropriated. 11

Section 10. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
