ORDINANCE 2022-501-E

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING ANNUAL TAXES FOR THE 2022 CALENDAR YEAR ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, NOT INCLUDING THE SECOND, THIRD, FOURTH AND FIFTH URBAN SERVICES DISTRICTS (THE CITIES OF ATLANTIC BEACH, NEPTUNE BEACH, JACKSONVILLE BEACH AND THE TOWN OF BALDWIN); STATING THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE FROM THE 2022 ROLLED-BACK RATE; AUTHORIZING ASSESSMENT AND PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION; THE USE OF THE REVENUES GENERATED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 Section 1. Ad valorem tax levy - General Services District, 20 excepting Urban Services Districts 2 through 5 (The Beaches and the 21 Town of Baldwin). In accordance with Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, 22 for the year 2022, there are hereby levied upon all taxable property 23 located within the General Services District of the city, excepting 24 the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Urban Services Districts, for 25 county, district and municipal purposes, ad valorem taxes expressed in terms of mills on each dollar of assessed taxable valuation in the 26 27 amount of 11.3169 mills, or \$11.3169 per \$1,000 assessed taxable 28 value.

Section 2. Percentage change from the rolled-back rate.
The 2022 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated

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City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services
 District of the city, excepting the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth
 Urban Services Districts, represents a 9.07% increase from the 2022
 rolled-back rate set forth in Resolution 2022-500-A.

5 Section 3. Assessment and collection. The Property 6 Appraiser of the county is authorized and directed to assess, and the 7 Tax Collector of the county is authorized and directed to collect, 8 pursuant to law, the ad valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance.

9 Section 4. Use of revenues. The revenues raised by the ad 10 valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance shall be utilized in the manner 11 and for the purposes specified in the 2022-2023 budget and 12 appropriations ordinance.

13 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Council President.
