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5 **ORDINANCE 2022-502-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CALENDAR YEAR 2022 ANNUAL
7 TAXES ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN
8 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, INCLUDING ONLY URBAN
9 SERVICES DISTRICTS TWO, THREE, AND FOUR, TO WIT:
10 THE CITIES OF ATLANTIC BEACH, NEPTUNE BEACH AND
11 JACKSONVILLE BEACH; STATING THE PERCENTAGE
12 CHANGE FROM THE 2022 ROLLED-BACK RATE;
13 AUTHORIZING ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION;
14 PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE REVENUES GENERATED;
15 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **WHEREAS**, the City of Jacksonville entered into interlocal
18 agreements with the cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach and
19 Neptune Beach in 1995, 1996 & 1998, respectively, which established
20 the millage rates as the difference between the City of Jacksonville's
21 General Services District's millage rate and 3.2907 mills; and

22 **WHEREAS**, this Ordinance establishes the millage rates for the
23 cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach, and Neptune Beach in
24 accordance with the Interlocal Agreements with these respective
25 cities and Chapter 200, *Florida Statutes*; now therefore

26 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 **Section 1. Ad valorem tax levy - General Services**
28 **District, including only Urban Services Districts 2, 3, and 4 (The**
29 **Beaches).** In accordance with Chapter 200, *Florida Statutes*, and the

1 Interlocal Agreements between the City of Jacksonville and the cities
2 of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach, and Neptune Beach, for the
3 year 2022 there are hereby levied upon all taxable real and personal
4 property located within the General Services District of the city,
5 including only the Second, Third, and Fourth Urban Services Districts
6 (the cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach, and Neptune Beach),
7 for county purposes, ad valorem taxes expressed in terms of mills on
8 each dollar of assessed taxable valuation in the amount of 8.0262
9 mills, or \$8.0262 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value.

10 **Section 2. Percentage change from the rolled-back rate.**

11 The 2022 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated
12 City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services
13 District of the city, including only the Second, Third, and Fourth
14 Urban Services Districts, represents a 8.74% increase from the 2022
15 rolled-back rate set forth in Resolution 2022-500-A, which is the
16 amount agreed upon in the Interlocal Agreements between the City of
17 Jacksonville and the cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach,
18 and Neptune Beach.

19 **Section 3. Assessment and collection.** The Property

20 Appraiser of the county is authorized and directed to assess, and the
21 Tax Collector of the county is authorized and directed to collect,
22 pursuant to law, the ad valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance.

23 **Section 4. Use of revenues.** The revenues raised by the ad

24 valorem taxes levied in this Ordinance shall be utilized in the manner
25 and for the purposes specified in the 2022-2023 budget and
26 appropriations ordinance.

27 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become

28 effective upon signature by the Council President.
